Cone Funeral Home is pleased to provide full disclosure of all pricing for funeral merchandise and services. The enclosed price list is provided to assist you in making selections. Further explanations and price list are available upon request.

The goods and services included in this price list are those we can provide. You may choose only the items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing in the document describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

Prices subject to change without notice. We reserve the right to refuse service.

All items marked with an asterisk (*) are included in full-service fees.

PROFESSIONAL SERVICES	
Basic Services of Funeral Director, Staff and Overhead	\$2,995

This charge includes but not limited to conducting the arrangement conference, planning the funeral, consulting with family and clergy, sheltering remains, preparing and filing necessary notices, obtaining authorizations and permits, coordinating with the cemetery, crematory, or other third parties, and a proportionate share of basic overhead costs.

This fee will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements selected. It is already included in our charges for full services, graveside services, and forwarding or receiving remains.

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary if you select certain arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require it, such as direct cremation, a memorial service, or a graveside service.

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Includes basic services of funeral director and staff; taking the deceased into our care; embalming and further preparation; use of CFH for up to three hours visitation session and funeral service; hearse; lead or flower vehicle within Warren County; and graveside service. Also includes the Deluxe Memorial Package and a basic newspaper notice. Available Monday through Friday as a same-day service during regular business hours. Weekend charge available.

Memorial Service with Two-Hour Visitation - Same Day; Body Not Present	\$3,195
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Includes basic services; transfer to CFH within Warren County; care of remains; basic cremation container; crematory fee; return of cremains; placement in a CFH temporary urn or urn purchased from CFH; two-hour visitation with memorial service at CFH; Deluxe Memorial Package; and basic newspaper notice. Available Monday through Friday. Weekend charge available.

Private Viewing with Cremation to Follow	\$3,400
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Monday-Friday, between 10:00 a.m.-3:00 p.m.; one-hour limit. Limited to spouse or next of kin only, with a maximum of 10 people. Includes transfer to CFH within Warren County; care of remains; washing; dressing; minimal cosmetology; use of our location and staff; crematory fee; return of cremains; and placement in a CFH temporary urn or urn purchased from CFH.

Table and cover included. Visitation must occur within 72 hours of passing. Embalming is not included.

Cone Funeral Home Payment Options

Cone Funeral Home has proudly served families in Bowling Green and Warren County since 2011. We have found that families want to understand their financial options before deciding funeral arrangements. A clear understanding of our payment policy makes matters easier concerning a funeral or memorial service.

All financial arrangements for funeral or cremation services must be settled before any public announcements or arrangements are made by Cone Funeral Home. Because of Federal Truth in Lending laws, Cone Funeral Home cannot provide in-house financing or monthly payment arrangements. You may wish to contact your financial institution if the options below do not meet your needs. Please speak openly with your funeral director concerning these confidential matters.

Option 1: Pre-Paid Funeral Contract

Funds deposited in The Funeral Funding Trust of Kentucky or in a pre-need burial insurance policy that is current and in good standing.

Option 2: Cash or Check

Full payment by cash or check is expected and due upon completion of the funeral service contract.

Option 3: Credit Card

Visa, Mastercard, American Express, and Discover are accepted. A 3% convenience fee is added to the total purchase.

Option 4: Insurance Assignment

Payment may be made by assignment of valid insurance by the current beneficiary from a company that confirms information and cooperates with payment of proceeds to the funeral home. Some insurance claims are outsourced to a third party. Their minimum service fee is passed to the family without markup.

Estates

Due to the uncertain time frame associated with estates, we do not invoice estates. If an estate is established, you remain responsible for payment of funeral expenses through one of the options above.

No services will be performed, and no merchandise will be ordered or released, until payment has been received in full.



WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW WHEN CHOOSING A CREMATION SERVICE

1. WHO?

Who makes the removal of your loved one?

2. WHERE?

Where is your loved one taken for safe keeping until the cremation takes place? Does the provider have an on-site crematory? If not, do they have a cooler?

What measures are taken to identify your loved one throughout the cremation process and afterward? Ask us about our five-step process.

4. WHEN?

When will your loved one be cremated after being brought into the provider's care?

5. HOW?

How do you know you are receiving your loved one's cremains?
