

GREGG COUNTY YOUTH EXPO
MARKET GOAT DIVISION RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. All entries in this division will be subject to the General Rules and Regulations of the Gregg County Youth Expo except where they conflict with the rules of this division, in which case the General Rules shall prevail.
2. All goats must be GCYE or Texas State Validated.
3. Any meat goat breed or crosses will be eligible to compete.
4. All goats will be required to be dehorned or tipped at dime size or larger.
 - 4.1. Removal of horns is not allowed on the show grounds.
 - 4.2. Scurs are permitted.
5. All goats must be slick shorn with 3/8 inch of hair or less, from the knee and hock up, prior to the time of check-in.
 - 5.1. Head and tip of tail clipping is optional.
6. All goats must weigh a minimum of 50 pounds and a maximum of 120 pounds at the official weigh-in time on the Official Show Schedule. This weight will be the official weight for record keeping purposes.
 - 6.1. Each entry will be weighed no more than twice.
 - 6.2. There will be a 5 pound scale tolerance.
7. Any goat deemed unworthy or unruly by the sifting committee will not be permitted in the show or sale.
8. All goats must be shown with a chain collar or show halter.
9. All goats will be placed in the ribbon sale order by the judge following the conclusion of the goat show.
10. Any deviation from these rules will require action from the Gregg County Youth Expo Board of Directors.
11. The decision of the judge is final.

BREEDING DOE DIVISION RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. RULES/REGULATIONS: Entries made in this department shall be subject to and each exhibitor agrees to abide by the General Rules and Regulations.
2. ENTRY LIMITATION: This show is intended to be an exhibition of doe's suited for market wether production. Doe's are not required to be registered.
3. OWNERSHIP: All entries must be owned and continuously cared for by the exhibitor from Oct. 30 through the date of the show.
4. IDENTIFICATION: All entries must have a form of identification including but not limited to an ear tag or tattoo.
5. SHOW WEIGHTS: Exhibitors will get an official show weight for their goat. All goats must meet the minimum weight requirement of 50 lbs. Weight changes will not be allowed at any time.
6. CLASSES: Classes will be broken by weight.
