

GREGG COUNTY YOUTH EXPO

BROILER DIVISION RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. All entries in this division will be subject to the General Rules and Regulations of the Gregg County Youth Expo except where they conflict with the rules of this division, in which case the General Rules shall prevail.
2. All chicks (quantity of 25 per entry) shall be ordered through the division superintendent, or designated board member, and will be distributed on a designated date at a designated time.
 - 2.1. Wing band forms must be returned to the division superintendent within seven (7) days of broiler distribution.
 - 2.2. Extra broilers will be distributed evenly among all exhibitors.
3. The exhibitor and exhibitor's FFA or 4-H advisor must certify that the broilers have been owned and fed by the exhibitor since the date of distribution.
4. A broiler entry consists of one (1) bird. Maximum of (2) entries per exhibitor.
5. Only one (1) live bird from the original distribution will be sifted and shown at the designated time on the Official Show Schedule.
 - 5.1. Any birds deemed not presentable by the judge will not be eligible for show. If In this case, the student may bring an alternate broiler.
 - 5.2. Family validation is acceptable.
 - 5.3. Any pen of broilers deemed unworthy by the show judge will not be permitted in the show.
6. Exhibitors of broilers must be present for the sift unless excused by the division superintendent and/or the Gregg County Youth Expo Board of Directors.
7. Broiler exhibitors, or approved substitutes, must be present to hold their broilers for The judge immediately followed the shift.
8. The one (1) birds selected for exhibition and show are NOT to be removed from

their pen except for showing.

9. The ribbon sale order will be determined by the final results of the judge.

10. Any deviation from these rules will require action from the Gregg County Youth Expo Board of Directors.

11. The decision of the judge is final.
