The state is an untouched jewel. By the time Langkawi is receiving its tourists, we hope the e-directory is completed to be fully utilised." added Uzaidi.

The development of the e-directory is expected to boost the productivity growth of the tourism industry in Perlis. TPN is an industry-led establishment under Malaysia Productivity Blueprint (MPB), which aims is to increase the productivity level of the sector. TPN is working closely with MPC Northern Region and Perlis State Government in building the e-directory.

Dato' Abdul Latif bin Haji Abu Seman, MPC Director General said, "We need to look forward and charter the recovery plan to really boost the productivity growth of the tourism industry. MPC is fully supportive of any effort that can facilitate the players to be productive again in their tourism businesses."
