**PLEASE TAKE NOTE OF THE FOLLOWING IMPORTANT INFORMATION:**

Collection of pupils: Children collected after 18H00 will incur a fine of R 50 per 15 minutes or part thereof.

Fixed services, such as aftercare, are elected on a per-term basis and may not be cancelled during the term. This is necessary to support effective operational and resource planning. Changes may only be made for a subsequent term.

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**ADDITIONAL INFO:**

1. Payments are due in advance on or before the first of every month.
2. To qualify for the annual upfront discount, fees need to be paid in full by 31 January 2027.
3. Tuition and Fixed Services may be selected on different payment terms. You may choose separate payment options for each service category according to your requirements.
4. One change to your payment plan is allowed per year (within cut-off dates).
5. Ad hoc services (such as ad hoc aftercare and holiday care) are billed separately and are due in the month billed.
6. Past students of Tyger Valley College or Trinityhouse qualify for a 10% discount on tuition fees (subject to verification).
7. Sibling discount applies when two or more siblings are enrolled at the same school brand or at The Bridge, in the same academic year. Sibling discount applies from the 2<sup>nd</sup> sibling onwards, based on grade. The ranking of siblings and associated percentage discount is determined by the student's grade in descending order. See below example of grades and associated discounts:
  - Sibling 1 (Grade 12): 0%
  - Sibling 2 (Grade 8): 5%
  - Sibling 3 (Grade 2): 10%
  - Sibling 4 (Grade 0): 15%
  - Sibling 5 onwards is capped at a 15% discount.
8. A student may only qualify for one bursary or discount applicable per academic year, whichever one is of the highest value.
9. If full payment is not received by 31 January 2027, the account defaults to the 12-monthly payment term.
10. Students joining from 1 February 2027 may only choose the 12-monthly payment term.
11. Students enrolling at any time during January 2027 will be charged from 1 January 2027, regardless of their actual start date.
12. Joiners from 1 February 2027 onwards will be billed the flat rate for the full month. Monthly fees are not pro-rated for number of days.
13. The academic year runs from 1 January 2027 to 31 December 2027, including all school holidays and public holidays.
14. The following notice period is applicable to Tuition fees:
  - A minimum of three calendar months' written notice is required for the cancellation of tuition services. Notice fees will apply where the required notice period is not served.
  - If students leave after 1 November or written notice is given after 31 July, full year fees are due. Final date to cancel for 2027 is 31 July 2027 due to the three calendar months' notice period.
15. Credits will be applied on the flat rate for the full month for students leaving before 1 November 2027. Monthly fees are not pro-rated for number of days.
16. Fixed services are committed on a per-term basis and may not be cancelled during the term, as these services are planned and resourced based on confirmed term enrolments. Please confirm the services you wish to commit to at the start of each term.
17. All ad hoc services and levies are non-refundable once incurred or billed.
18. Annual payment term must be settled via EFT (no debit orders are available for this payment term). Monthly payments can be settled via EFT or debit order. Parents selecting the debit order method must provide banking details and proof of account. Failed debit orders must be settled via EFT. The following debit order dates are available:
  - 1st of the month (in advance)
  - 15th of the month (arrears)
  - 25th of the month (in advance)
19. The debit order processed is the amount reflecting as current on the monthly account statement.
