

Crash The Clunkers Rules

1. No drivers under 16. Guardian's consent needed for anyone under 18
2. Any front wheel drive car 1990 to newer is allowed - no large boat cars like large Buicks or Cadillacs are allowed. AWD is not permitted. Compact trucks/SUVs are allowed in the truck class. 2wd only. If you have 4wd, the front drive shaft must be removed. Steel top only. No convertibles or soft tops allowed.
3. Both cars and trucks must have a roll cage/demo bar. Any car without one will be disqualified. You can have a full roll cage if you want but only if it's made from actual roll cage metal (no fence posts, conduits, etc.).
4. All glass, lights, and exterior plastics must be removed. This includes the windshield.
5. All cars and trucks must have DOT approved tires. If you do not have them, you'll be disqualified from racing.
6. All cars and trucks must have a number painted on the sides of the vehicles and a sign with your number must be located on the roof of your vehicle (white with black writing) large enough to be seen from the grandstands.
7. Helmets are REQUIRED. No helmets, no racing.
8. Driver only in the vehicle. No passengers.
9. All doors, and trunks must be welded shut. Hoods need to have a pin to hold it in place.
10. NO ATTITUDE. This is for fun! Rubbing is racing, but this is not a demo derby. If you are aggressively driving and intentionally hitting others hard, you will be removed from the race. Pushing and shoving to gain position is okay.
11. Bumper mods are allowed, but if we see that they have been designed with the intentional intent to tear up other cars or tires, you will be asked to remove the bumper before you are qualified to race. If they are not attached well, you will be asked to remove it as well.
12. No nitrous
13. If you are found to be intoxicated, you will be disqualified. This is for everyone's safety.
14. Registered Drivers only. No driver substitutions. No exceptions.
15. Door bars (interior or exterior) are required on the driver's side to protect you.
16. All cars and trucks will be fully inspected before the race. If you do not follow the rest of the rules, you will be disqualified from racing.
17. All vehicles must have a 15" x 15" hole in the hood for fire safety.
