You will register for a specific check-in time when you sign up projects in Fair Entry

This applies to Clover Kids, 4-H, and FFA members.

ALL projects need to be entered on Fair Entry by JUNE 10 @ 11:59 PM. If there's any chance that a project will come, enter it. Any projects added between June 11-17 will be subject to the \$100 late fee.

- **Clover Kids:** Will check-in in the back room of the Extension Office. We will ask only Clover Kids beyond the check-in table. Parents, please wait in the waiting area. After judging, we ask members and parents to help carry the projects to the Activity Building.
- **4-H / FFA Members:**
 - Starting June 12, project tags will be available for pick up at the Extension Office or can be mailed to you upon request. This allows you to attach tags to projects before judging day.
 - All paperwork (i.e goal sheets) must be complete ***BEFORE*** Exhibitor checks in
 - Check-in window is located at the Cambridge Building at the Jefferson County Fairgrounds. Please arrive 15-20 minutes before your scheduled judging time.
 - The window clerks will give you your entry tags per project and supplies to hang tags on the project and Exhibit form, if tags were not already picked up or Exhibit forms were not already attached. A space will be provided for you to do this if needed.
 - If you have large exhibits, please let the window clerk know. You may be able to place them directly into the Activities Building and have the project judged there.
 - Once all projects are tagged, exhibitors will proceed to the ***Waiting Area***, where they will receive a number and then wait until their number has been announced to proceed with judging. Parents will be asked to wait outside or in the waiting area.
 - Judges will have specific areas to judge, and you may be visiting with multiple judges depending on the number of projects you exhibit and the project areas. After visiting with each judge, exhibitors will take projects to the specified table where volunteers will attach ribbons. We ask exhibitors and parents to carry projects to Activities Building to be displayed. Exhibits selected for State Fair Consideration will be set aside.
 - After all your exhibits have been evaluated, return your Judging Sheet with ribbon placements to the Check-out Table. You will receive your premium money after the fair.

Clothing Event and Interviews

All Clothing Event entries must be made in Fair Entry by the June 10 deadline. Clothing Interviews will be held on June 16 from 4-6 PM. We cannot generate a schedule for interviewing until after the June 10 Fair Entry Deadline. The schedule will be emailed to families on the morning of June 11. If you foresee any scheduling conflicts for the June 16 Judging Day and will need to request a specific time between 4-6 PM, please let the Extension Office know right away. These interviews are for 4-H only, not Clover Kids. The Clothing Event will take place on Monday, June 24 at 1 PM, during the Communications Event, where exhibitors will model their outfits and results will be announced. Communications Event

All Clothing Event entries must be made in Fair Entry by the June 10 deadline. The Communications Event will be held on Monday, June 24 at 1 PM. Judging will take place at the event and results will be announced at the conclusion of the event.
