 - a. Legal Council advises that the elevator at the XIT building should be repaired for handicap accessibility to the upstairs at the building. Home Elevators out of Amarillo evaluated the damages and have ordered parts for the repair.**
 - b. XIT building needs someone on location during events to maintain the building.**
 - c. Underwood Law Firm Municipal Law Seminar was a success. Two Council members and three staff attended. There were 60 attendees onsite and 120 online. City Attorney Slater Elza donated registrations to the City of Bovina.**
 - d. We continue to work on bringing the City Website up to date.**
 - e. Parts have been ordered for the repairs on Sergio's pickup. He continues to use his personal pickup.**
 - f. The Police Department Tahoe is back in operation.**
 - g. We added \$28,060.00 to the sidewalk project in front of City Hall. The existing curb and gutter had some structural concerns that were evident after the removal of the sidewalk. After conversations with the engineer it was decided that it needed to be replaced to insure the integrity of the project and the existing street.**
 - h. Kolby Bonham will attend Code Enforcement school in Beaumont instead of San Antonio. The San Antonio School was full.**
 - i. Electricity power surge affected the pumps communication system at the wastewater treatment plant. Repairs are in the works now. A claim has been filed with TMLIRP for the damages.**
 - j. We had a pump go out at the lift station. Parts have been ordered for that repair. Repair quote is \$5,78900. Parts have been ordered.**
 - k. Early voting for the Reauthorization of Street Maintenance Tax is April 20 – April 28 with Election Day May 2, 2026.**
