- g. CXM Consulting is performing the audit on our IT at this time. It was delayed since we couldn't get access from Jesus for our system.
- h. Sergio's pickup is in the shop in Muleshoe and work should be completed soon.
- i. The sidewalk project continues and should be completed soon. Rain showers have extended the timeline.
- j. Congratulations to the Chamber of Commerce for a successful July 4th celebration. Thank you to the City Public Works, Police, and Fire Departments for their work making this event a success.
