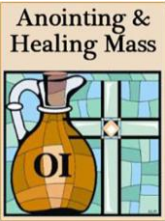

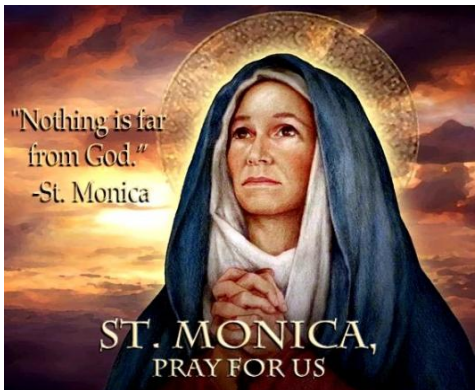
The Order of Christian Initiation
