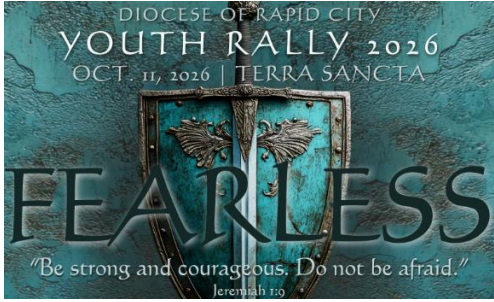
A SAFE ENVIRONMENT FOR CHILDREN AND YOUNG PEOPLE
