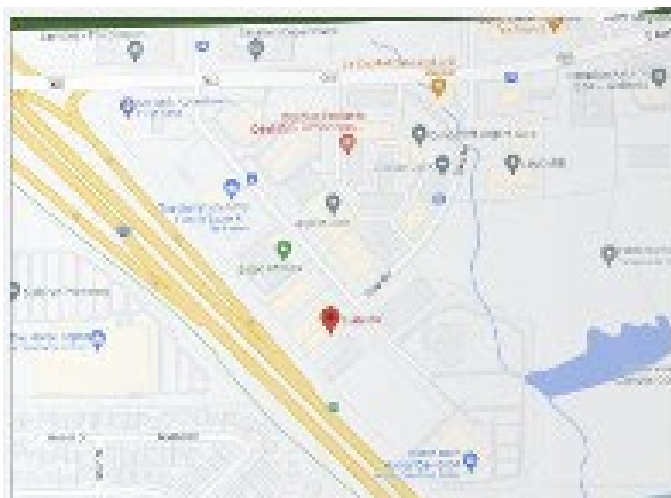

- We will notify the Social Security Administration, Veteran's Administration and other agencies when applicable on your behalf.
- We can assist you and your family with writing an obituary as well as placement in the newspaper and/or on our website.
- We have a small room for you and your family to spend some time with your loved one for a private family viewing. We can also help coordinate for a larger church service viewing.
- Prayer Cards, Bookmarks, Memorial Folders, and flower arrangements are all handmade by our caring staff.



What are the Steps?

1. Determine who is next of kin. In the state of Nevada the order goes (1) Designee (2) Spouse (3) Adult Children (4) Parents (5) Siblings. If there is an executor of the will or trust, they will take precedence over next of kin.
2. Discuss with family what you would all like done. Some things to consider: Will you want to do a viewing? Will there be a service? Burial or Cremation? Would you like to have an obituary published? Would you like any prayer cards or memorial folders? Will anybody like to have a keepsake or jewelry that holds some ashes?
3. Also, discuss whether you would like us to place a death notice or obituary in the paper for your loved one. Whether you would like prayer cards, bookmarks, memorial folders, etc printed for you and your family in memory of your loved one.
4. Call us to schedule an appointment so we can go over the proper forms with you. If the next of kin is not local, we can email the proper forms for them to fill out and sign.
5. Once we have met with you and received the vital information, we will send it over to the doctor to get a signature on the record. After that, it goes to the health department to become a burial permit. A burial permit is required to order death certificates and to move forward with cremation or burial.
6. We notify social security; however, if you wish to apply for benefits you will need to contact the Reno office at (800) 772-1213 to schedule an appointment.



What you will need for your appointment:

1. If you are the executor of the will or the executor of the trust, you will need to bring in your documents for us to keep on file.
2. Social security number for your loved one.
3. State your loved one was born in.
4. The name of the father and maiden name of the mother of your loved one.
5. If your loved one is a veteran and you would like to receive a flag or you would like to have them placed at the Veteran's Cemetery, we will need a copy of their DD-214 (discharge paperwork).

We know this is not an easy time and always suggest that families take all the time they need before coming in to start paperwork.
