

ADMISSION POLICY

1. Families with children currently enrolled, including Preschool students, and in good standing with All Souls Catholic School. *(Must be enrolled by March 1, 2025 to secure enrollment in the class for the 2025-2026 school year.)*

2. Families who are active parishioners* of All Souls Parish, who have been members in good standing for a minimum of one year, ranked according to their registration date with the Parish. The active parishioner must be the legal guardian of the student enrolling in All Souls School.

Families changing residence and joining All Souls Parish who present a letter from their previous pastor stating that they were active parishioners may receive equal consideration. The letter from their previous parish should state the date they were first members of that parish.

3. Families who are active parishioners* of neighboring parishes, who have been members in good standing for a minimum of one year, ranked according to their registration date with their parish.

Families changing residence and joining a neighboring parish who present a letter from their previous pastor stating that they were active parishioners may receive equal consideration. The letter from their previous parish should state the date they were first members of that parish.

4. All other families not currently attending All Souls Catholic School.

*All new students are subject to a 90-day probationary period.

*The pastor will determine which families are “active parishioners.” Factors which the pastor may consider include: regular attendance at Mass by looking at the use of the Mass passport system, involvement in parish ministry (for example, lector, usher, Eucharistic Minister, special projects, etc.). Families must be registered for at least one year.
