Travel by public transport

Bus

- The nearest stop is for Bus Route 14C with the major stops of:
 - Darwin Interchange
 - Cullen Bay
 - Darwin Waterfront.
- The Route 14C bus is wheelchair accessible.
- It's approximately 100 m away with a step-free route available.
- Darwin Interchange is approximately 450m from the restaurant with step-free access to the Waterfront.

Free Waterfront Shuttle from Kitchener Drive

- The Shuttle bus operates at peak lunch and dinner times; from 11:30 am to 2 pm and 4 pm to 9 pm. Linking Stokes Hill Wharf, the Cruise Ship Terminal, residential apartments and hotels. The stop is approximately 70 m from the venue.
- The Shuttle is not wheelchair accessible.



Getting Here



Drop-off

- There is a drop-off point on Kitchener Drive with a kerb ramp approximately 70 m from the entrance.
- The route to the restaurant has a path greater than 1000 mm wide and a level concrete surface.


Street Parking

- Parking on Kitchener Drive is \$3 per hour for a maximum of 2 hours. Accessible Parking is not available.
- Parking on Anchorage Court is \$2.50 per hour.
- Patrons with a valid Accessible Parking permit displayed on their windscreen can park in any car park on-street for double the time as signposted at no cost.
- Anchorage Court has three Accessible parking bays located at Fort Hill near 5 Anchorage Court. The venue is approximately 270 m from these bays.





Getting Here




Kitchener Drive multi-storey car park

- Accessible parking is located on levels 2 and above, with five spaces close to the lifts. From the car park to the entrance of the restaurant there is step-free access.
- In use is a ticketless parking system. Payment is cashless and can be made by debit or credit card at the pay machines near the lifts or upon exit at the boom gate.
- Parking is free for under two hours.
- The venue is approximately 140 m from this car park.



Arrival



Path to the main entrance

- The external terrain is concrete. From the frontage to the main entrance, there is level access.



Main entrance

- The door is at least 800 mm wide.
- There is a clear, level path of travel from outdoor to indoor areas.

Getting Around



What to expect

- There are two dining areas inside. One dining area is at the rear of the restaurant with one step to access the platform area. There are large tables and booths.
- The second dining area is next to the bar and has a mix of tall and standard tables and chairs.
- The outdoor dining is undercover.
- Toilets are located inside.
- The kitchen is closed off from the dining areas.
- Indoor flooring is a mix of tiles and wooden floorboards.
- Outdoor flooring is concrete.
- Moderate contrast between furniture and flooring and high contrast between walls and door frames.
- Children's equipment: A change table is located in the accessible toilet and high chairs are available.
- Air conditioning is available indoors and fans are available outdoors.



Indoor Dining- Near the Bar



Clear Floor Space

- There is a clearance of approximately 1000 mm on average between tables allowing forward or parallel approach to the tables.
- Tables can be repositioned as required.



Furniture

- **Tables with slanted legs:** Have a height of 750 mm with an under-table clearance height of 715 mm.
- There is unrestricted knee and foot clearance.
- **Tables with low cross bar:** Have a height of 740 mm with an under-table clearance height of 665 mm. There is restricted foot and knee clearance.
- **Seating:** Cushioned chairs with backrests have a seat height of 450mm.
- Wooden firm dining chairs without backrests have a seat height of 440mm.



Indoor Dining- Near the Bar



Furniture

- **Tall Large Table:** The table height is 1060 mm and has restricted foot and knee clearance due to the crossbar.
- **Tall Pedestal Table:** The table height is 1060 mm with restricted foot and knee clearance.
- **Tall Straight-legged Table:** The table height is 1070 mm with restricted foot and knee clearance.
- **Seating:** Firm chair with backrest with a seat height of 740 mm.



Indoor Dining- Rear area



Access

- One step with a height of 180 mm with no rail.



Furniture

- **Small Pedestal Tables:** Have a height of 755 mm with an under-table height of 677 mm. There is restricted knee and foot clearance.
- **Large tables** Have a height of 740 mm with an under-table clearance height of 665 mm. A crossbar restricts foot and knee clearance.
- **Seating:** The cushioned chair with a backrest has a seat height of 440 mm.
- **Booths:** The table height is 715 mm and the height of the clearance underneath is 645 mm.
- **Seating:** Cushioned benches with a seat height of 450 mm.



The Bar



- Located inside at the entrance of the restaurant, the bar height is 1190 mm.

Clear Floor Space



- There is clear floor space around the bar, however, the area may become crowded with customers and staff.



Outdoor Dining



Clear Floor Space

- There is suitable floor space for most mobility aids and tables can be repositioned to allow a forward or parallel approach.



Furniture

- **Large Tables:** The large table height is 735 mm and the height of the clearance underneath is 670 mm. There is unrestricted knee and foot clearance.
- **Seating:** Firm wooden benches have a seat height of 450 mm.
- **Small Tables:** The height is 740 mm with a clearance height underneath of 670 mm. There is unrestricted knee and foot clearance.
- **Seating:** Black firm chairs without armrests have a seat height is 450 mm.



Toilets



- The toilets are located next to the ATM and off the bar room.
- There is level access to the toilets
- There is a Unisex LHS Accessible toilet and standard male and female toilets.
- Flooring- Tiles
- High contrast signage with braille at 1385 mm height.
- There is a level path of at least 850 mm to access toilets.
- There are 3 standard toilet cubicles





Accessible Toilets



- The door width of the accessible cubicle is 1380 mm
- The door opening is slightly restricted by the hand rail behind the door.
- The door has a round door knob with a small twist lock.
- Flooring- Tiles



- The toilet height is 430 mm
- Clear floor space to the right of the toilet is 1355 mm and to the left is 275 mm.
- Rails are on the left-hand side and rear of the toilet with a height of 820 mm.





Accessible Toilets



- The basin is located in the cubicle with a lever action tap at a height of 810 mm.
- The soap dispenser is at 825mm.
- There is adequate knee and foot clearance under the basin.
- There are paper towel dispenser at 1260 mm and another at 780 mm.



- Lighting in the cubicles and hand washing areas is automatic.



- There is a baby change table installed in the cubicle.





Communication




External Wayfinding

- The venue is identified with large signs surrounding the venue.

Menus

- The drinks and food menus are provided in written format.
- A QR code is available on the tables to access food menus online and make payment.
- Staff are available to read out all menus to assist with any access requirements.





Sounds



Bar

Typical sounds from the bar include sounds from glasses, bottles and cocktail shakers.



Music

There is background music at all times, however, this can be adjusted on request. Music is louder at night, and can be adjusted on request.



Customers

The volume of sound from customers will depend on peak periods and functions. Please contact the venue for more information on existing bookings.



Kitchen

The kitchen is closed off from the dining areas.





Scents



Food

The main scents you will experience will be from the food served.



Hand wash

Mildly scented hand wash is located in the bathrooms.



Air freshener

Air Freshener may be used on occasion.





Lighting



Indoors

- Both indoor dining areas are well-lit in the day with bright, non-glaring light with approximately 150 lux.
- In the evening the indoor area has bright lighting in most areas. The lighting of 150 lux is available in some areas according to the positioning of tables under lights.
- Lighting can be adjusted on request.



Outdoors

- During the day the outdoor space is lit with natural lighting.
- In the evening, the tables with the brightest lighting of up to 100 lux border the walkway/ entrance to the venue.



Dietary Requirements



We cater for most dietary requirements however we do not have dietary safe zones and there may be a risk of cross contamination.

Service




Peak Periods

- During the Dry season, the peak periods are daily between 12:30 - 2pm and 6pm - 9pm.
- Wet seasons are quieter.
- If you would like to attend in a quieter period it is advised to contact the restaurant to for further information
