Getting Here

Drop-off

- There is a drop-off point on Kitchener Drive with a kerb ramp approximately 240 m from the entrance.
- The route to the restaurant has a path greater than 1000 mm wide and a level concrete surface.





Getting Here

Street Parking

- Parking on Kitchener Drive is \$3 per hour for a maximum of 2 hours. Accessible Parking is not available.
- Parking on Anchorage Court is \$2.50 per hour.
- Patrons with a valid Accessible Parking permit displayed on their windscreen can park in any car park on-street for double the time as signposted at no cost.
- Anchorage Court has three Accessible parking bays located at Fort Hill near 5 Anchorage Court. The venue is approximately 450 m from these bays.





Getting Here



Kitchener Drive multi-story car park

- Accessible parking is located on levels 2 and above, with five spaces close to the lifts. From the car park to the entrance of the restaurant there is step-free access.
- In use is a ticketless parking system. Payment is cashless and can be made by debit or credit card at the pay machines near the lifts or upon exit at the boom gate.
- Parking is free for under two hours.
- The venue is approximately 210 m from this car park.



Getting Here



Travel by public transport

Bus

- The nearest stop is for Bus Route 14C with the major stops of:
 - Darwin Interchange
 - Cullen Bay
 - Darwin Waterfront.
- The Route 14C bus is wheelchair accessible.
- It's approximately 160 m away with a step-free route available.
- Darwin Interchange is approximately 550m from the restaurant with step-free access to the Waterfront.

Free Waterfront Shuttle from Kitchener Drive

- The Shuttle bus operates at peak lunch and dinner times; from 11:30am to 2 pm and 4 pm to 9 pm. Linking Stokes Hill Wharf, the Cruise Ship Terminal, residential apartments and hotels. The stop is approximately 240 m from the venue.
- The Shuttle is not wheelchair accessible.



Arrival



Path to the main entrance

- The external terrain is concrete. From the frontage to the main entrance, there is ramped access.
- The path is 1000 mm wide, or more.



Main entrance

- There is a clear path of travel from outdoor to indoor areas.
- There are multiple open areas with automatic sliding doors.
- The automatic sliding doors have a clearance greater than 1000 mm wide.





Getting Around



What to expect

- Inside: there is the Main Bar, the Nook and the Gaming Lounge.
- Outdoors: the Terrace and the Beer Garden.
- Outdoor dining is undercover.
- Toilets are located inside near the bar.
- The kitchen is closed off from the dining areas.
- Flooring: wooden floorboards and carpet indoors.
- There is high contrast between the furniture and flooring and high contrast between walls and door frames.



- Air conditioning is available indoors.
- Fans are available indoors and outdoors.
- Change tables are located in the accessible toilets. High chairs are available





Indoor Dining - Main Bar



Clear Floor Space

- There is greater than 1000 mm between most tables and tables can be repositioned to increase circulation space.
- Concrete flooring and floorboards in this area.



Furniture

- **Tall Tables:** A height of 935 mm with a clearance height underneath of 855 mm.
- **Seating:** Tall stools without backrests have a seat height of 645 mm
- **Low Tables:** The table height is 755 mm with a clearance height underneath of 695 mm.
- **Seating:** Chairs without armrests have a seat height of 460 mm.






Indoor Dining - Big Screen Area



Stage

- The stage has three steps up without a rail.
- There is low lighting in this area.
- Visual stimulus includes multiple small screens with different images/broadcasts and a large screen.

Clear Floor Space

- Tables can be repositioned to increase circulation space to allow a forward or parallel approach to the tables.
- Flooring- Tiles lead to carpet.



Furniture

- **Rectangle Tables:** Pedestal tables have a height of 750 mm and an under table clearance of 740 mm. They have a depth of 370 mm restricting knee and foot clearance.
- **Seating:** The chairs without armrests have a seat height of 460 mm.



The Bar



- Located at the main entrance of the venue.
- The bar height is 1100 mm.



Clear Floor Space

- There is clear floor space around the bar, however, the area may become crowded with customers and staff.
- There are televisions broadcasting sports installed at the bar.



Outdoor Dining - Terrace



Clear Floor Space

- There is restricted circulation space with less than 1000 mm between most tables however tables can be repositioned to increase floor space.



Furniture

- **Large Wooden Tables:** The table height is 955 mm and the under-table clearance height is 833 mm.
- **Seating:** The tall black chairs without armrests have a seat height of 660 mm.
- **Low Pedestal tables:** Have a height of 730 mm and the under-table clearance height is 713 mm.
- **Seating:** Cushioned chairs with armrests have a seat height of 440 mm.





Outdoor Dining - Terrace



Furniture

- **High Square Tables:** The pedestal table height is 1115 mm and the height of the clearance underneath is 1077 mm.
- **Seating:**
 - Grey stools with back rests have a seat height of 750 mm
 - Wooden stools have a seat height of 760 mm.



Outdoor Dining - Beer Garden



Clear Floor Space

- There is at least 1000 mm between most tables to allow a forward or parallel approach.



Furniture

There is a range of tall and standard tables.

- **Low Wooden Tables:** The table height is 760 mm and the height of the clearance underneath is 670 mm.
- Foot and knee clearance may be restricted by the support brace.
- **Seating:** The benches without backrests may be difficult to maneuver and have a seat height of 435 mm.





Outdoor Dining - Beer Garden



Furniture

- **Low Tables:** The pedestal table height is 750 mm and the height of the clearance underneath is 723 mm.
- There is restricted foot and knee clearance.
- **Seating:** Black plastic chairs without armrests have a seat height of 450 mm.
- These chairs have low contrast against the flooring.



Trailer

- The Trailer service counter height is greater than 1000 mm.
- There is clear floor space around the trailer, however, the area may become crowded with customers and staff.



Gaming Lounge




- Located off the Main Bar.
- There is level access from both the external and internal entry.



- Clear floor space of at least 1000 mm in most areas.



- There is a bar located in the Gaming Lounge with a bar height of 1080 mm.





Restrooms



- The toilets are located to the left of the bar.
- There is a Unisex RHS Accessible toilet and standard male and female toilets.
- Flooring- Tiles
- Clear signage indicates the different toilets.
- The Change table is located in the Accessible Toilet.
- Lighting in the cubicles and hand washing areas is automatic.





Accessible Toilet



- The door of the accessible cubicle swings inward to the left when entering.
- The door width is greater than 800 mm
- There is a fixed D-shaped door handle to enter and exit the toilet with a height of 1050 mm (lowest point).
- The toilet lock is a large lever lock style toilet indicator at a height of 900 mm.
- Flooring- Tiles





Accessible Toilet



- The toilet height is 460 mm
- Clear floor space to the right of the toilet is 270 mm and to the left is 1655 mm.
- Rails are on the right-hand side and to the rear of the toilet with a height of 800 mm.



- The level shower has a mixed lever-style tap.



- The basin is located in the cubicle with a mixed lever action tap at a height of 780 mm.
- There is unrestricted knee and foot clearance under the basin.
- The soap dispenser is at 1000 mm.
- There is a paper towel dispenser at 1530 mm and a hand dryer at 1010 mm.





Communication

External Wayfinding

- The venue is identified with large signs surrounding the venue.

Menus

- The drinks and food menus are provided in written format.
- Staff are available to read out all menus to assist with any access requirements.





Sounds



Bar

Typical sounds from the bar include sounds from glasses, bottles and cocktail shakers. There are televisions installed at the bar. Music is audible in the bar area.



Customers

The volume of sound from customers will depend on the number attending the venue.

The Nook area is typically the quietest area of the venue.



Kitchen

The kitchen is separate from the dining areas and sounds from the kitchen are limited in the restaurant area.





Sounds



Music

There is background music at all times, however, this can be adjusted on request.

Live music on Sunday afternoons, with moderate to loud sound. Can be adjusted in certain areas on request.



Big Screen Area

High visual and auditory sensory load due to big screens, small screens, background music and gaming screens with additional sounds.



Scents



Food

The main scents you will experience will be from the food served.



Hand wash

Mildly scented hand wash is located in the bathrooms.



Air freshener

Air Freshener may be used on occasion.





Lighting

Indoors

- The Bar area has lighting between 20 and 130 lux.
- The big screen area has low lighting and low glare with lighting between 20 and 110 lux. The brightest area is situated near the window, under the light.
- The Nook area generally has low light. The lighting is 60 lux if the table is situated under the lights.
- The DJ on Saturdays has flashing / strobe lights.
- Lighting can be adjusted in most areas except the Nook.

Outdoors

- During the day the outdoor space is lit with natural lighting and string lights.
- In the evening, the tables with the brightest lighting of up to 100 lux border the walkway/ entrance to the venue.



Dietary Requirements

We cater for most dietary requirements however we do not have dietary safe zones and there may be a risk of cross contamination.

- During the Dry season, the bar area is busy on Friday and Saturday nights.
- Music on Sunday afternoons has a more relaxed atmosphere.
- If you would like to attend in a quieter period it is advised to contact the venue for further information in case there are special events booked.

- Orders can be placed at the bar. Table service can be provided as required and payment can be made at the tables using cash or card.
