Travel by public transport

Bus

- The nearest stop is for Bus Route 14C with the major stops of:
 - Darwin Interchange
 - Cullen Bay
 - Darwin Waterfront.
- The Route 14C bus is wheelchair accessible.
- It's approximately 230 m away with a step-free route available.
- Darwin Interchange is approximately 600 m from the restaurant with step-free access to the Waterfront.

Free Waterfront Shuttle from Kitchener Drive

- The Shuttle bus operates at peak lunch and dinner times; from 11:30am to 2 pm and 4 pm to 9 pm. Linking Stokes Hill Wharf, the Cruise Ship Terminal, residential apartments and hotels. The stop is approximately 220 m from the venue.
- The Shuttle is not wheelchair accessible.



Getting Here



Drop-off

- There is a drop-off point on Kitchener Drive with a kerb ramp approximately 220 m from the entrance.
- The route to the restaurant has a path greater than 1000 mm wide and a level concrete surface.





Getting Here



Street Parking

- Parking on Kitchener Drive is \$3 per hour for a maximum of 2 hours. Accessible Parking is not available.
- Parking on Anchorage Court is \$2.50 per hour.
- Patrons with a valid Accessible Parking permit displayed on their windscreen can park in any car park on-street for double the time as signposted at no cost.
- Anchorage Court has three Accessible parking bays located at Fort Hill near 5 Anchorage Court. The venue is approximately 170 m from these bays.





Getting Here



Kitchener Drive multi-story car park

- Accessible parking is located on levels 2 and above, with five spaces close to the lifts. From the car park to the entrance of the restaurant there is step-free access.
- In use is a ticketless parking system. Payment is cashless and can be made by debit or credit card at the pay machines near the lifts or upon exit at the boom gate.
- Parking is free for under two hours.
- The venue is approximately 300 m from this car park.

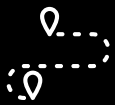
Path to the main entrance

- The external terrain is concrete. From the frontage to the main entrance, there is level access.
- The path is 1000 mm wide, or more.



Main entrance

- There is a clear path of travel from outdoor to indoor areas.
- The main entrance is level with concertina doors that remain open.
- The doors have a clearance greater than 1000 mm wide.



Getting Around



What to expect

- There is outdoor and indoor dining. Seating arrangements are modified according to the event and may vary from the setup indicated.
- Table service only.
- Outdoor dining is undercover.
- Public toilets are located external to the venue with accessible toilets available.
- The open kitchen is located near the entrance.
- Flooring: tiles.
- There is a high contrast between the furniture and flooring.
- Children's equipment: Change tables are located in the nearby toilets and high chairs are available
- Air conditioning and fans are available indoors.

Clear Floor Space

- Clearance between tables varies and tables can be repositioned to increase circulation space allowing a forward or parallel approach.



Furniture

- **Pedestal Tables:** The height is 770 mm and the clearance underneath is 740 mm. There is restricted knee and foot clearance.
- **Seating (chairs):** The black and brown chairs are firm and without armrests. They have a seat height of 470mm.
- **Seating (stools):** Tall stools against the windows have a low backrest and a seat height of 650mm.



Outdoor Dining



Clear Floor Space

- There is greater than 1000mm between most tables outdoors.
- Tables can be repositioned to increase floor space allowing forward or parallel approach.

Furniture



- **Pedestal Tables:** The low pedestal table height is 750 mm and the height of the clearance underneath is 730 mm.
- **Seating:** Cushioned chairs without armrests have a seat height of 470 mm.
- **Wooden Tall Table:** The height is 760 mm with a clearance height underneath of 720mm.
- **Seating:** Tall stools with small backrest have a seat height of 650 mm



Outdoor Dining



Furniture

- **Round High Tables:** The pedestal table height is 960 mm and the height of the clearance underneath is 920 mm.
- **Pedestal Tables:** The low pedestal table height is 750 mm and the height of the clearance underneath is 730 mm.
- **Seating- High stools** without armrests or backrests have a seat height of 710mm.
- **Seating- Brown chairs** are firm and without armrests. They have a seat height of 470mm.





Toilets



- There are nearby public toilets approximately 20m from the cafe.
- Flooring- Tiles
- Wayfinding to the toilets is limited and you may require directions from staff.
- There are Male, Female and Unisex Accessible Toilets.
- There are baby change tables located in the female toilets and in the accessible toilets.

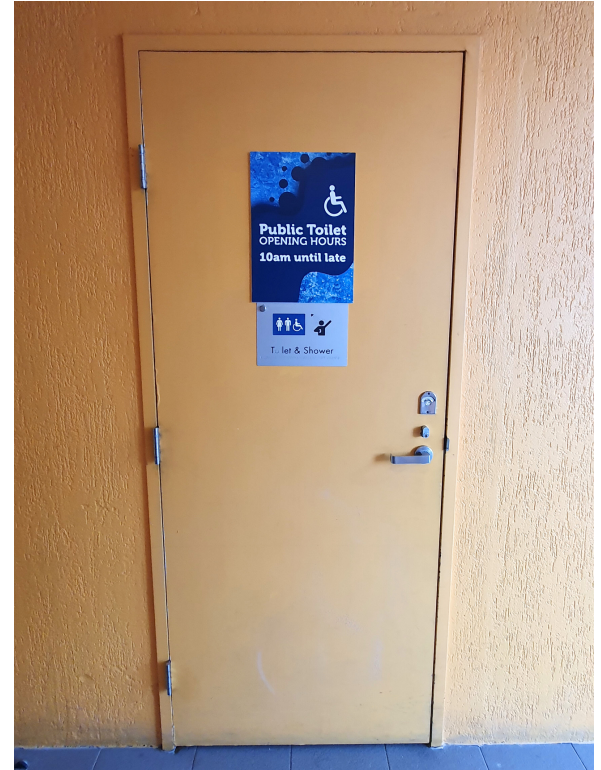




Accessible Toilets



- The door of the cubicles swings outward to the left when entering.
- The door width is greater than 800 mm
- There is a door lever handle to enter and exit the toilet with a height of 1000 mm.
- The toilet lock is a traditional style toilet indicator bolt design at a height of 1170 mm.
- Flooring- Tiles
- The shower in this bathroom is out of operation.





Accessible Toilets



Accessible Toilet


- The toilet seat height is 450 mm
- Clear floor space to the right of the toilet is 720 mm and to the left is 240 mm.
- Rails are on the left-hand side of the toilet with a height of 830 mm.
- An emergency call alarm is located on the wall next to the toilet.
- The sanitary bin can be repositioned as required.



Accessible Toilets



Hand washing area

- The basin is located in the cubicle with a lever action tap at a height of 770mm.
 - The soap dispenser is at 1000 mm.
 - There is a power point next to the basin with a height of 1000 mm.
 - There is knee and foot clearance under the basin.
 - There is a paper towel dispenser at 1450 mm.

- Lighting in the cubicles and hand washing areas is automatic.

- The venue is identified with large signs surrounding the venue.

- Staff are available to read out all menus to assist with any access requirements.

Sounds



Bar

Typical sounds from the bar include sounds from glasses, bottles and cocktail shakers.



Music

There is background music at all times, however, this can be adjusted on request.



Customers

The volume of sound from customers will depend on the number attending the event. During Peak periods, the quietest area of the venue is typically indoors.

The kitchen is near the entrance to the bar and sounds from the kitchen are limited in the restaurant area.

Mildly scented hand wash is located in the bathrooms.

Lighting



Indoors

- Both indoor dining areas are well-lit in the day with around 150 lux.
- In the evening the indoor area has bright lighting in most areas. The lighting of 150 lux is available in some areas according to the positioning of tables under lights.



Outdoors

- During the day the outdoor space is lit with natural lighting and string lights.
- In the evening, lighting over 150 lux is available depending on the location of the seating.

Service



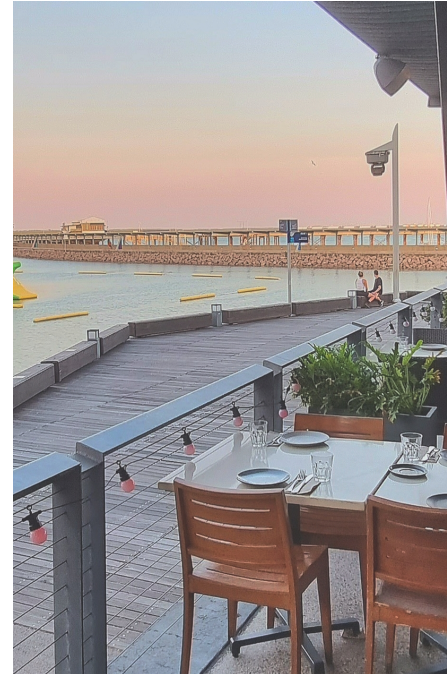
Peak Periods

- During the Dry season, the peak periods are Friday, Saturday and Sunday from 6pm - 8pm.
- On Friday and Saturday, the quietest period is around 4pm.
- If you would like to attend in a quieter period it is advised to contact the restaurant to for further information.
