Travel by public transport

Bus

- The nearest stop is for Bus Route 14C with the major stops of:
 - Darwin Interchange
 - Cullen Bay
 - Darwin Waterfront.
- The Route 14C bus is wheelchair accessible.
- It's approximately 230 m away with a step-free route available.
- Darwin Interchange is approximately 550m from the restaurant with step-free access to the Waterfront.

Free Waterfront Shuttle from Kitchener Drive

- The Shuttle bus operates at peak lunch and dinner times; from 11:30am to 2 pm and 4 pm to 9 pm. Linking Stokes Hill Wharf, the Cruise Ship Terminal, residential apartments and hotels. The stop is approximately 220 m from the venue.
- The Shuttle is not wheelchair accessible.



Getting Here



Drop-off

- There is a drop-off point on Kitchener Drive with a kerb ramp approximately 220 m from the entrance.
- The route to the restaurant has a path greater than 1000 mm wide and a level concrete surface.





Getting Here



Street Parking

- Parking on Kitchener Drive is \$3 per hour for a maximum of 2 hours. Accessible Parking is not available.
- Parking on Anchorage Court is \$2.50 per hour.
- Patrons with a valid Accessible Parking permit displayed on their windscreen can park in any car park on-street for double the time as signposted at no cost.
- Anchorage Court has three Accessible parking bays located at Fort Hill near 5 Anchorage Court. The venue is approximately 450 m from these bays.





Getting Here



Kitchener Drive multi-story car park

- Accessible parking is located on levels 2 and above, with five spaces close to the lifts. From the car park to the entrance of the restaurant there is step-free access.
- In use is a ticketless parking system. Payment is cashless and can be made by debit or credit card at the pay machines near the lifts or upon exit at the boom gate.
- Parking is free for under two hours.
- The venue is approximately 100 m from this car park.



Arrival



Path to the main entrance

- The external terrain is concrete (entrance from the street and waterfront). From the hotel to the entrance, there is level access.
- The path is 1000 mm wide, or more.



Entrance from Waterfront

- There is one step of 170 mm without a hand rails.
- Alternatively, there is ramp access to the left of the main door.
- The manual door to the indoor dining has a width of 1000 mm and is level.



Arrival



Entrance via Hotel

- The internal entrance has an in-swinging door with a clear width of 895 mm.
- The entrance has step-free access.





Getting Around



What to expect

- There is indoor and outdoor dining.
- Outdoor dining is undercover.
- The toilets are located on the ground floor of the hotel.
- The kitchen is separate to the dining area.
- Flooring (inside): wooden floorboards.
- Flooring (outside)- Pebbled concrete and tile.
- Moderate contrast between the furniture and flooring.
- Air conditioning is available indoors. Fans are available indoors and outdoors.



HIH Indoor Dining



Clear Floor Space

- Clear floor space between tables is greater than 1000 mm allowing a forward or parallel approach to the tables.



Furniture

- **Pedestal Tables:** The height is 750 mm and the clearance height underneath is 720 mm. Depth to the pedestal is 415 mm and may restrict foot and knee clearance.
- **Seating:** Firm chairs without armrests, the seat height is 440 mm
- **Long table:** The height is 740 mm and the clearance height underneath is 710 mm. Unrestricted foot and knee clearance.
- **Seating:** Firm chairs without armrests or backrests, the seat height is 455 mm.



The Buffet



- Located at the rear wall of the restaurant.
- The buffet height is between 950 -1100 mm.



Clear Floor Space

- There is floor clearance approaching the buffet greater than 1000 mm.
- There is no knee or foot clearance at the buffet table allowing a parallel approach only.



The Bar & Service Counter



- The service counter is located at the entrance of the restaurant.
- The counter height is 1065 mm.
- There is task lighting available.



Clear Floor Space

- There is clear floor space around the Counter.





Outdoor Dining



Clear Floor Space

- There is greater than 800 mm between some tables, however others have restricted floor space. Tables can be repositioned to increase space to allow a forward or parallel approach.



Furniture

- **Seating:** There is bench seating without armrests, the seat height is 440 mm.
- **Standard Height Tables:** The pedestal table height is 740mm and the height of the clearance underneath is 725 mm.
- **Seating:** Firm chairs without armrests with a seat height of 460 mm.



Outdoor Dining



Furniture

- **High Tables:** The height is 1060 mm with a clearance height underneath of 1000 mm.
- **Seating:** Tall stools without armrests, the seat height is 755 mm






Toilets



- There are accessible toilets as well as standard male/female toilets available for the guests of Curve Cafe & Bar.
- The accessible toilet is located on the ground floor near the Foyer of Vibe and Adina Hotels.
- Wayfinding is limited and you may ask staff for directions as needed.



- There is a baby change table in the Accessible Toilet.





Accessible Toilets



- The corridor leading to the toilets area approximately 1540 mm wide.
- The door width is greater than 850 mm
- There is a lever handle to enter and exit the toilet with a height of 1000 mm.





Accessible Toilets



- The toilet height is 460 mm
- Clear floor space to the right of the toilet is 2215 mm and to the left is 275 mm.
- Rails are on the left-hand side and to the rear of the toilet with a height of 800 mm.
- A duress alarm is situated to the left of the toilet at a height of 900 mm.



- The basin is located in the cubicle with a lever action tap at a height of 780 mm.
- The soap dispenser is at 1150 mm.
- There is unrestricted knee and foot clearance under the basin.
- There is a paper towel dispenser at 1000 mm.



Sounds



Bar and Service Counter

Typical sounds from the bar include sounds from glasses, cocktail shakers and the coffee machine.



Music

There is background music at all times, however, this can be adjusted on request.



Customers

The volume of sound from customers will depend on the day and hour. The quietest area of the venue is typically the space indoors.



Kitchen

Is located separate to the dining area.



Scents



Food

The main scents you will experience will be from the food served.



Hand wash

Mildly scented hand wash is located in the bathrooms.



Air freshener

Air Freshener may be used on occasion.





Lighting

Indoors

- The indoor dining area is well-lit in the day with 100 - 1000 lux according to the positioning of tables under lights.
- In the evening the indoor area has bright lighting in most areas.



Outdoors

- During the day the outdoor space is lit with natural lighting and string lights.
- In the evening, the tables with the brightest lighting of up to 100 lux border the walkway/ entrance to the venue.



Dietary Requirements

We cater for most dietary requirements however we do not have dietary safe zones and there may be a risk of cross contamination.



Peak Periods

- During the Dry season, the peak periods are between 12:30- 2 PM and 4PM - 6 PM. most days.
- If you would like to attend in a quieter period it is advised to contact the restaurant for further information

- Table service is provided and payment can be made at the tables using cash or card.
