Design Exhibit Guidelines:

1. Designers are expected to hand deliver their designs the day and time listed below

for each category you will exhibit. DO NOT ship your garment to the hotel. Garments

can be lost, customs can delay arrival, and hotel handling fees are excessively high.

2. Your garment must be dressed on the form by the time stated on the day of your

assigned exhibit. Any form not dressed will be pulled from the proceedings.

3. You must arrive at the gallery with your garment on the designated day and time

listed below to begin dressing and preparing your form. Tear-down will begin at the

end of the exhibit time (except for exhibit 1 for details see below) and must be

completed within the 30 minutes time allocated for tear-down.

4. To ensure the safety of your garment(s), please make sure your garments are

removed by that time. ITAA will not be responsible for any garments left after that

time.

It is required that the designer or mentor be present during the gallery opening time with their garment, or the item will be disqualified.

- 1. As you can see, the time frame between when the forms are taken down and the forms are prepared for the next group is very short. To make this happen, we are asking that everyone volunteer to help move and reposition the dress forms for either Exhibit 1 or Exhibit 2 and attend promptly.
- 2. The form size is mainly small and medium unless the given measurements indicate a plus size, or a specific form size is requested by the designer. Know you are welcome to bring padding, straight pins, and/or safety pins to help your garment fit the form you will be using.
- 3. Thank you for your cooperation in meeting these tight display deadlines. Working together we will have a great conference and a lovely, mounted exhibit!
