ABOUT REGENT'S UNIVERSITY LONDON:

Regent's University London is London's is a private university with a highly cosmopolitan community based in royal Regent's Park. The campus is located in a vibrant part of central London, home to fashion design houses, artists, advertising companies, and interior design practices, making it an excellent setting to inspire your creative and commercial talents. Regent's is small and intimate enough to feel like a 'home away from home'. With just under 3,000 students on campus, staff and students get to know each other by name, and students benefit from plenty of one-on-one contact with their instructors. The Regent's staff are dedicated to ensuring that students enjoy their time at Regent's and reach the ambitious goals that they have set for themselves. Most of the teaching at Regent's takes place in small groups with high contact hours. Therefore, students build a powerful relationship with their instructors.

SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION/CRITERIA:

- The Regent's University London Will Conard Scholarship for Fashion Merchandising and Fashion Design is awarded to an undergraduate student enrolled in a fashion marketing/merchandising program OR fashion design, which has a current ITAA member on the faculty.
- Each school/university may sponsor only one applicant per year. Therefore, it is the responsibility of the school/university to decide who the applicant will be.
- Students must be a current member of ITAA to apply and receive the award.
- Students can win the award only once. Therefore, if a student has received the award in the past, he or she may not reapply.
- Free tuition and housing (University coordinated housing only) for an upcoming regular academic term (Fall/Spring or Summer program at the Regent's University London campus. Therefore, the award may not be applied retroactively or used as a reimbursement for students who have already completed terms or who are currently attending a Regent's University London Study Abroad Program (i.e., applicants are not eligible for a refund for existing tuition or fees).
- Recipient must use the award within one year of notification.
- The student must have completed a minimum of two years of a fashion marketing/ merchandising OR fashion design program before applying.
- The student must have at least one term to complete at the sponsoring school/university after participating in the study abroad experience at Regent's University London.
- The Student Fellowships and Awards Committee will review the completed application packages and determine the recipient after December 15. All applicants will be notified of the Committee's decision as soon as possible.

SUBMISSION PROCEDURE:

Undergraduate students, who meet all of the above scholarship selection criteria, adhere to the required submission deadline, and submit a complete application package, will be considered for this scholarship. The application package for the Regent's University London – Will Conard Scholarship for Fashion Merchandising OR Fashion Design must include all of the following requirements for consideration (incomplete or late submissions will not be considered):

- (1) Completed application form.
- (2) *Sponsorship letter from department head/chair verifying that you are the school's representative for the Regent's University London – Will Conard Scholarship for Fashion Merchandising OR Fashion Design. The letter must be on official department letterhead, include your major and overall grade point average, and must be signed by the department head/chair.

- (3) *One letter of recommendation from an ITAA faculty member. The letter should address how long the ITAA member has known the applicant and in what capacity, the applicant's academic and leadership abilities, extracurricular and community involvement, and potential for future contributions to the profession. The letter must be on official department letterhead and must be signed by the ITAA member.
- (4) Transcripts (unofficial is acceptable) from all institutions of matriculation.
- (5) Examples of student work. This can include, but is not limited to reports, essays, PowerPoint presentations, and/or visual work.

*The sponsorship letter and letter of recommendation may be combined into one letter, if your department head/chair is (1) an ITAA member; (2) familiar with you and your work/achievements; and (3) willing to expand the sponsorship letter by also including the required information for the letter or recommendation.

The applicant/submitter is responsible for completing, obtaining, and providing all of the above scholarship requirements as a complete application package. The above scholarship requirements must be combined (a complete application package) and saved into one basic Adobe Acrobat PDF file (PDF Portfolios will not be accepted). The PDF file should be named as follows: RegentsFashionMerch-Applicant Name OR RegentsFashionDes-Applicant Name Finally, the PDF file should be uploaded by July 1 using the submission link via the ITAA website.

In order to complete and electronically sign the application, you must download the application and save it to your computer or external device.
