Embalming.....\$825

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.

Direct

Cremation.....\$1,795

If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering) You may provide your own container (must meet crematory standards)

Forwarding of Remains to Another Funeral Home

This charge includes the transfer of remains, embalming and professional care, basic services, of Funeral Director, staff, facilities, overhead, motor equipment, procuring necessary authorizations and permits, minimum shipping container or airway. This charge does not include ceremony of any type, casket or shipping charges.

Receiving Remains from Another Funeral

Home.....\$1,995

This charge includes basic services of Funeral Director, staff, facilities, overhead, motor equipment, procuring necessary authorizations and permits, transfer of remains to cemetery. This charge does not include preparation of the remains, shipping, transportation, use of facilities and staff for visitation, public or private ceremony (except in options below), prior to burial.

1. Receiving remains with visitation and traditional chapel or church services..... \$1,985

3. Receiving remains with disposition only (no public or private service).....\$1,250
