Please join us for the "Redlands En Plein Air" Painting Competition on March 9th. In the chance of rain March 16th Pre-Registration is required to participate.

Please read the following carefully as this outlines the expectations for artist participation in this event.

Competition Entry Information and Requirements

- 1. Pre-Registration by March 9th is required. Walk-ins will NOT be accepted on the event day.
- 2. Artists are required to check-in on the event day any time from 8am to noon, March 9 at the Citrograph Printing Co. Painting will end at 4pm that same day. Artist must check back in that same day from noon throu 4pm to verify their artwork.
- 3. Upon Check-in, artists will have 1-3 canvases stamped before commencing painting. Please limit canvase to 12"x16" or smaller.
- 4. Each artist may deliver one finished painting (watercolor, pastel, oil, acrylic) for the Plein Air Contest.

 Additional artwork done that day may be left for the Art Show and Sale.
- 5. Attach provided artist card to the backside of the submitted paintings.
- 6. After it has been verifed, Artwork should be framed and ready to hang on that same day (Remember to bring frames!).

 Work must have screw eyes or d-rings and wire (no saw-toothed hangers).
- 7. Prizes for 1st, 2nd, 3rd and honorable mention.
- 8. The Citrograph Foundation will require a price point from the artist when they drop off their artwork.

 One art piece of each participant will be displayed on the weekend of March 16th, location: DTR Art Walk in front of the Citrograph building
- 9. Judging will be done by a judge of your peers. This years judge will be Terry d. Chacon
- 10. Money made from the sale will be a 50/50 split with each artist piece and the Citrograph Foundation. Artist may choose to donate their art piece or their portion of the sale to the foundation.
- 11. Artists need to pick up all unsold artwork by March 29th. Any unsold artwork not picked up will become the property of the Citrograph Foundation, Inc.
