



Spring Yard Cleanup Checklist

A Practical Late-Spring Checklist for PNW Homeowners

Lawn & Beds

- Clear leftover branches, needles, and organic debris from lawn edges and garden beds
- Remove moss buildup and inspect for thin or patchy grass areas
- Reseed or lightly dethatch areas struggling after winter moisture
- Refresh mulch and complete a thorough spring garden bed cleanup
- Define lawn edges to improve appearance and simplify ongoing maintenance

Overgrowth & Trimming

- Trim shrubs, hedges, and perimeter growth before late-spring growth accelerates
- Check walkways, fences, and siding for encroaching plants or branches
- Remove overgrowth that traps moisture against the home

Drainage & Moisture

- Watch for soft spots, standing water, or uneven drainage
- Inspect low-lying or shaded areas for lingering saturation
- Check gutter and downspout flow to ensure water drains away properly

Large Debris & Cleanup

- Remove leftover materials like broken planters, fencing, lumber, or yard waste piles
- Schedule junk removal for bulky items or debris that has accumulated over winter
- Create a manageable maintenance plan before summer use increases
