Creekside is a dual-campus K-12 school in Henry County, GA (pop. 281,700). The Lower Academy (K-5) is located in McDonough; the Upper Academy (6-12) is located in Hampton. Situated about 30 minutes south of Atlanta, CCA is a suburban school, though it is in one of the fastest growing counties in the state.

Accreditation

Creekside is accredited by ACSI (Association of Christian Schools International), SACS (Southern Association of Colleges and Schools), and Cognia.

Curriculum & Requirements

1. Creekside students are held to Georgia graduation requirements in addition to institutional requirements. A total of 24 credits are needed to graduate: 4 English, 4 Math, 4 Science, 3 Social Science, 2 Foreign Language, 1 Physical Ed/Health, and 6 Bible/Elective.
2. Most curriculum used is by Bob Jones Press and Abeka. Students participate in daily Bible classes, weekly chapel services, and have biblically integrated coursework for all other subjects.
3. Honors-level and Dual Enrollment courses available for high school students.
4. HS core classes have an average of 13 students per class.

Testing & Benchmarks

1. Seniors are required to take the SAT/ACT by senior year; grades 9-11 take the PSAT in the fall; grades 1-8 take the TerraNova 3 in the spring.
2. Mean SAT (2022 cohort): 1048 Mean ACT Composite (2021): 20.8 TN3: 82.5% of subjects tested met/exceeded state standards

Post High School

1. Over 75% of the class of 2021 qualified for the HOPE Scholarship; about 51% qualified for the Zell Miller Scholarship (calculated by HOPE GPA).
2. About 75% of graduates go to a 4-year college, 15% go into workforce/trade, 9% go to a 2-year/technical school, and 1% go into the military (based on data from the last 3 years).
3. Top 5 colleges of interest: Kennesaw State, Georgia Southern, Georgia State, Clayton State, and Georgia College (all USG institutions).

Grades & Transcripts

1. Scale: A (90-100), B (80-89), C (74-79), D (70-73), F (0-69)
2. All GPAs are unweighted on a 4.0 scale. Any extra credit or weight is added only to final grade averages (for Honors, Dual Enrollment, etc.).
3. Students are ranked according to overall averages. Every course attempted is included in this calculation and is present on the transcript.
4. Final grades are calculated from the following: tests are 40%, midterm and final exams are 20%, quizzes are 20%, and daily/homework grades are 20%.
