### **Lock Down Drill**

In Wisconsin, state law requires all public and private schools to conduct at least one annual school violence and safety drill. We will be conducting this drill sometime this week. Last week, we reviewed the different types of drills and procedures related to potential threats of violence. In addition to meeting state requirements, practicing these routines can help students and staff respond more calmly and effectively during emergency situations, which may help reduce trauma in the event of a real emergency.
