Principal's Report: Michelle Hagen

- Provided an overview of the budget
 - The budget was originally built on an enrollment of 170
 - A new budget was built on an enrollment of 175
 - MGC currently has an enrollment of 176
 - The per pupil dollar amount is around 10,000
 - Operational budget of school is around 1.8 million dollars
 - Salary structure
 - The goal was for fair and equitable salaries
 - Salaries from the original budget needed to be adjusted
 - Current expenses are around 1.7 million dollars
 - The textbook cost was over \$48,000
 - We will be getting some second-hand social studies books
 - Next year a social studies series will need to be looked into
- Possibility of having K3 in January
 - o Michelle has fielded numerous calls about interest in K3

Cafeteria Report: Michelle Hagen

- A new cafeteria manager was hired
- We did not pass our most recent health inspection
- We also had some issues with compliance with the state Food Program
- We are an all-school free lunch program. We need to have 62.5% pupil participation in the benefit program to maintain this. Right now we are at 65%.
- Teachers have received training on the new program guidelines
- Possibility of finding new food vendors or creating more meals from scratch

ECP Report: Michelle Hagen

- ECP and Cafeteria pay some of their money back to the school
 - No specific rate
- ECP is in a good place budget-wise
- Benny's report:
 - Enrollment of 54 students
 - Hours from 6:30 AM-7:30 3:15-6:00 PM
 - Daily attendance is around 42 students
 - o The summer program went well
 - The weekly schedule was shared

Athletic Report: Carden Mahler's notes

- Over 50 kids are participating in Fall Soccer and Volleyball
- Looking forward to a basketball and cheer season
