Day 1 | Monday, September 6, 2027 | Whitefish Point • Tahquamenon Falls

Depart by motorcoach for Michigan's legendary Shipwreck Coast at Whitefish Point. Uncover the powerful story of Great Lakes shipwrecks and see the recovered bell of the Edmund Fitzgerald. Feel the thunderous beauty of the Upper and Lower Tahquamenon Falls before gathering for a warm Welcome Dinner. (D)

Day 2 | Tuesday, September 7, 2027 | Oswald's Bear Ranch • Pictured Rocks Boat Tour

Come face-to-face with the Upper Peninsula's beloved black bears before cruising beneath the towering sandstone cliffs, colorful formations and hidden coves of Pictured Rocks National Lakeshore. Discover an unexpected collection of whimsical outdoor art and enjoy free time along Munising's waterfront. (B, D)

Day 3 | Wednesday, September 8, 2027 | Keweenaw Peninsula

Enjoy a fun stop celebrating the wonderfully quirky humor and personality of the Upper Peninsula. Explore the rugged shoreline and historic communities of the Keweenaw Peninsula with a local guide, then visit a unique bakery and gift shop featuring handcrafted preserves and baked goods created by Byzantine monks. (B, D)

Day 4 | Thursday, September 9, 2027 | Quincy Mine • Porcupine Mountains

Tour a historic copper mine and descend into Michigan's fascinating mining past as you discover the stories of the people who shaped Copper Country. Savor an authentic pasty lunch inspired by the region's mining heritage, then continue into the Porcupine Mountains for sweeping wilderness views from the Lake of the Clouds Overlook. (B, L, D)

Day 5 | Friday, September 10, 2027 | Rail & Sail Apostle Islands • Duluth

Cruise among the rugged shorelines, historic lighthouses and striking formations of the Apostle Islands. Continue to Duluth, step into the golden age of rail travel and cap the day with a memorable dinner train experience. (B, D)

Day 6 | Saturday, September 11, 2027 | Minnesota's North Shore • Thunder Bay

Stand above Lake Superior at iconic Split Rock Lighthouse, then ride a mountain gondola for expansive views across Lake Superior. Cross into Ontario and settle into a waterfront hotel for a two-night stay. (B, L, D)

Day 7 | Sunday, September 12, 2027 | Kakabeka Falls • Thunder Bay

Watch the Kaministiquia River plunge over the dramatic rock ledges of Kakabeka Falls. Step back into the fur-trade era at an immersive living-history experience and discover the beauty of Ontario's official gemstone during an amethyst mine visit. Enjoy free time to explore Thunder Bay at your own pace. (B, L)

Day 8 | Monday, September 13, 2027 | Lake Superior's North Shore • Wawa

Follow one of Canada's most spectacular routes along Lake Superior's northern shore, pausing at scenic overlooks where rugged cliffs, dense forests and brilliant blue water meet. Enjoy lunch along the way, take in the beauty of the lake's protected islands and waterways, and stop at the towering Wawa Goose. (B, L)

Day 9 | Tuesday, September 14, 2027 | Agawa • Sault Ste. Marie

Browse Canadian-made gifts, Indigenous crafts and intricate woodcarvings before cruising through the engineering marvel of the Soo Locks alongside massive Great Lakes freighters. Complete the day with an engaging look at Canada's bushplane and aviation heritage. (B, D)

Day 10 | Wednesday, September 15, 2027 | Journey Home

Cheer on talented competitors during the fast-paced Jack Pine Lumberjack Show, featuring chopping, sawing, axe throwing, speed climbing and logrolling. Depart for home with unforgettable memories of Lake Superior. (B, L)
