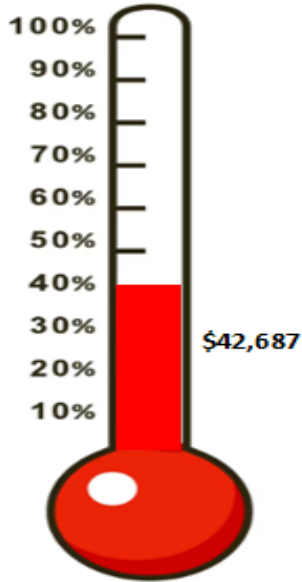

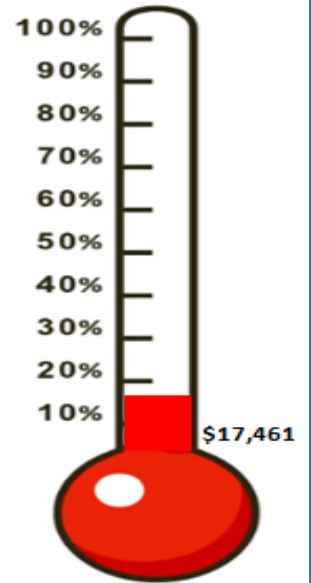

Señor, gracias por enseñarme a orar. Hoy, humilde e insistentemente, pido tu ayuda para sacar el mayor provecho de esta oración, quiero conocerte mejor para amarte más. Confío en tu misericordia sabiendo que, en la medida en que te ame y te escuche, podré transmitirte a los demás. Señor Jesús, ayúdame a hablar con el Padre, como Tú lo hacías.

Meditación del Papa: ¿Cómo aprendo a orar, como crezco en mi oración? Mirando el modelo que Jesús nos enseñó, el Padre Nuestro, vemos que la primera palabra es "Padre" y la segunda es "nuestro". La respuesta, entonces, es clara: aprendo a orar, alimento mi oración, dirigiéndome a Dios como Padre y orando-con-otros, orando con la Iglesia, aceptando el regalo de sus palabras, que me resultan poco a poco familiares y ricas de sentido. El diálogo que Dios establece con cada uno de nosotros, y nosotros con Él, en la oración incluye siempre un "con"; no se puede orar a Dios de modo individualista. En la oración litúrgica, especialmente en la Eucaristía, y --formados de la liturgia--, en cada

oración no hablamos solo como individuos, sino que entramos en el "nosotros" de la Iglesia que ora. Y tenemos que transformar nuestro "yo" entrando en este "nosotros". (Benedicto XVI, 3 de octubre de 2012).

Reflexión: Señor, enséñanos a orar. La oración es el diálogo del hombre con Dios. He aquí la grandeza de la oración. Jesús enseñó a sus discípulos la más grande de las oraciones, el Padre Nuestro. En esta oración de Jesús se da una relación filial del hombre con Dios. Hablar como hijos y no como siervos ante alguien desconocido, decir Padre a Dios. Padre Nuestro, es el Padre que nos espera ansioso en la casa, como el Padre del hijo pródigo; es el Padre que nos da el pan diario, que es su Hijo en la Eucaristía, como lo dio en el desierto a los israelitas, para alimentar a los peregrinos de este mundo. Pedir con insistencia y con la fe de que recibiremos, así debemos pedir como nos enseña Jesús. Lo primero es fácil, siempre pedimos por nuestras necesidades, por el trabajo, por el hijo enfermo etc. Pero pedir con fe, no es así de fácil. La fe requiere confianza y es una virtud que no se practica mucho en nuestro

tiempo. Si tuviésemos la fe como un granito de mostaza diríamos a un árbol plántate en el mar y así sería. También hay que pedir por la fe, como aquel padre que pedía por su hija enferma: Señor creo, pero aumenta mi fe. Aunque Jesús ya sabe lo que necesitamos antes de pedirlo. ¡Cuán grande es la clemencia del Señor, cuán grande la difusión de su gracia y bondad, pues que quizo que orásemos frecuentemente en presencia de Dios y le llamemos Padre; y así como Cristo es hijo de Dios, ¡así nos llamemos nosotros hijos de Dios! (San Cipriano). Es mejor si este diálogo se hace espontáneamente, de corazón a Corazón. Jesús, ayúdame a conocer cada vez mejor a tu Padre en la oración. Dame la gracia de amarle como verdadero hijo, quiero confiar en Él, abandonándome a su voluntad y providencia. Que el tiempo para mi oración personal sea lo más importante en mi agenda de cada día. Y te suplico me ayudes a que sepa irradiar este espíritu de oración en mi familia.

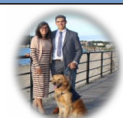
