

2026-2027 Good Shepherd Middle School Student Supplies

All Middle School Students- please place these items in a bag(s) with your student's name on the bag(s) and bring them to the Science Lab during our Back to School Bash or on the first day of school.

- 2 boxes (100+) of tissues
- 3 rolls of paper towels
- 1 pack (4 count or larger) fine-tip dry erase markers (Math and Spanish)
- 1 pack (12 count or larger) sharpened pencils for shared classroom use (all subjects)
- 1 24-count pack of colored pencils for shared classroom use (Science)
- 2 paint pens of any color for shared classroom use (Art)
- 1 box (50+) of plastic coated small paperclips (Reading)
- **6th Grade students only**- 1 pair of ANSI approved safety goggles (in a gallon ziploc bag with your name on it)
- ELA Books (only the books for your grade and put in a gallon ziploc bag with your name on it)
 - **6th grade:** *Ground Zero* by Alan Gratz and *Ungifted* by Gordon Korman
 - **7th Grade:** *The Invention of Hugo Cabret* by Brian Selznick, *Towers Falling* by Jewel Rhodes, and *The Phantom Tollbooth* by Norton Juster
 - **8th Grade:** *In The Shadow of the Fallen Towers* by Don Brown and *Restart* by Gordon Korman

All Middle School Students- Bring the first day of school; personal student supplies:

- 2 (any color) 1-subject **wide-ruled** spiral notebooks (Grammar, SS)
- 3 (any color) **wide-ruled** composition notebooks (non-perforated pages) (Math, Religion, Spanish)
- 2 (any color) 3-ring binders (1-inch) with looseleaf notebook paper in them (Writing & Science)
- 1 8-pack divider tabs (Science)
- 1 pack graph papers (Science)
- 1 2-pocket folder (Spanish)
- 1 zippered pencil pouch with the following supplies:
 - #2 sharpened pencils
 - Colored pens (1 of each: blue, black, green, red, purple)
 - 2 highlighters
 - 1 black sharpie
 - 1 jumbo glue stick
 - 1 (12 count) colored pencils
 - 1 large eraser (white hi-polymer preferred)
 - 1 pair of scissors
 - 1 enclosed pencil sharpener (manual only)
 - 1 pair of over the ear corded headphones (no ear buds), kept in locker
 - TI30-x-iis Scientific Calculator (you should be able to find it for under \$15). New students and all 6th graders need to purchase; all returning students should already have one; those students who completed 7B Math last year and are taking Algebra this year will also benefit from having a TI-84 graphing calculator (please check with Mrs. Jones before purchasing).

Each student should also have extra pencils, pens, wide-ruled notebook paper, glue sticks, etc at home to keep refilling supplies as needed.

We recognize that many students want college-ruled paper in Middle School. However, we respectfully request that students use wide-ruled paper only.

RETURNING BAND STUDENTS:

- Musical Instrument and instrument specific supplies
 - Trumpets: valve oil, slide grease, snake, mouthpiece brush, polishing cloth
 - Trombones: slide cream or misting bottle OR slide oil, slide grease, mouthpiece brush, polishing cloth
 - French Horn: rotary valve oil, slide grease, mouthpiece brush, polishing cloth
 - Clarinets and Alto Saxophones: (1) pack of 10 reeds (Rico, Rico Royal, or Vandoren brand)-2.5 strength, cork grease and cleaning swab (comes as a kit with your rental), reed guard to hold four reeds)
- Foundations for Superior Performance by Richard Williams- for your instrument
- Music stand for at-home practice
- 4 sharpened pencils

- Band instruments will be determined through a placement test with Ms. Waters. Band Rental Night information will be sent home the first day of school.
