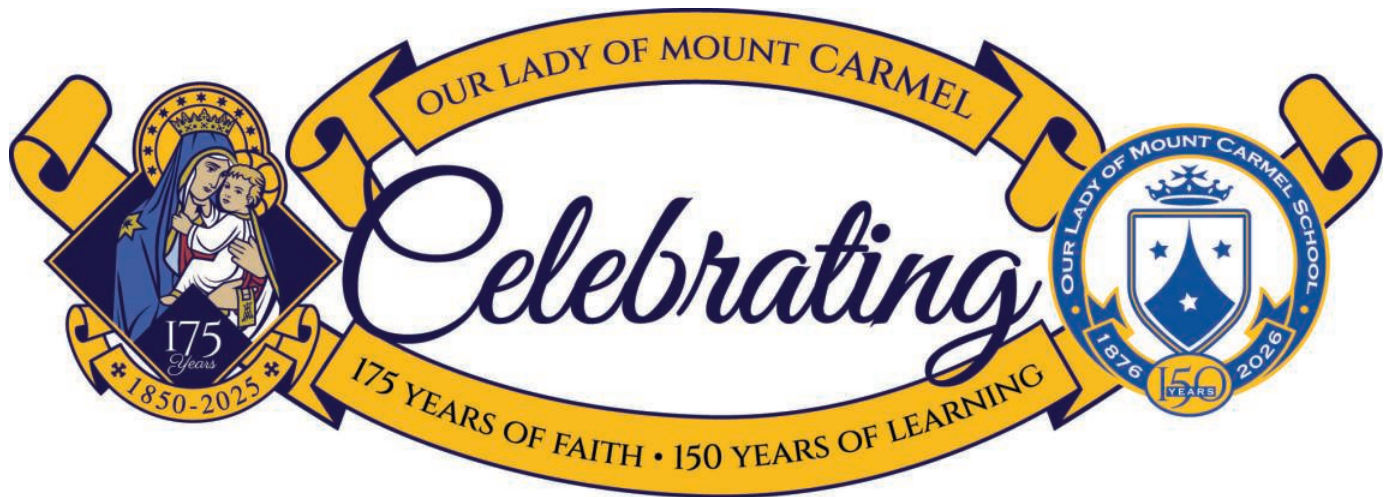




In 2008, I led a pilgrimage of 60 high school students to Australia to celebrate *World Youth Day* with Pope Benedict XVI.

In the weeks and months leading up to the trip, I had to remind the students (and myself) that this was a pilgrimage and not a vacation. Canceled flights, sleeping in airports, lost passports, lost baggage and awful food made those words come true.

On a pilgrimage, one doesn't get caught up in pleasure-seeking. Pilgrims walk long hours during the day and sleep wherever they can. And if you give up you're never going to finish your mission.

As we begin Advent, the readings for Mass invite us to renew our commitment to live as pilgrims on our way to the "heavenly Zion."

Mount Zion is a privileged place throughout the Bible. It was on Zion that Abraham agreed to do the unthinkable: trust in God by preparing to sacrifice his son. On Zion, Solomon built his magnificent Temple. And in a humble little house ... on Mount Zion ... Jesus celebrated the First Eucharist at the Last Supper.

This mountain is spiritually understood to be a foreshadowing of heaven, itself.

Isaiah the prophet really helps us in our pilgrimage through Advent. He's the author of our first reading which was written during a time when Israel was on the brink of annihilation. Assyria had reduced Jerusalem to



a pile of rubble. The people found themselves outnumbered, powerless, and discouraged.

Isaiah, however, had a vision of hope as – on Mount Zion – he predicts that *swords will be beaten into plowshares and spears turned into pruning hooks*.

These words give us hope in the midst of our darkness while challenging us to transform whatever is ungodly within us into peaceful thoughts, words and actions. We can do this through prayer and honest introspection.

We've added a Noon Mass – every weekday – and increased time for confession during Advent. Let's take advantage of all the Church offers us ... and complete our mission to celebrate the birth of Christ with joy!

Flanking the Our Lady of Mount Carmel statue on her right is the St. John Neumann Columbarium Wall. Our Lady of Mount Carmel has very close ties to St. John Neumann. As the fourth Bishop of Philadelphia, Bishop Neumann purchased the land our church stands on today, and laid the cornerstone for our first church in 1855. Bishop Neumann also visited here many times for Confirmations.

Bishop John Neumann was very dedicated to education and established the first Catholic diocesan school system in the US. As an immigrant himself, he became a symbol of hope and support for immigrants in the United States. His care for the health and well-being of children during a cholera epidemic led to his association with the protection of sick children.

He left us too soon at the age of forty-eight in 1860. Canonized in 1977. Saint John Neumann is the Patron Saint of Immigrants and sick children. There is a low stone wall for rest and reflection surrounding the OLMC statue. Come pay a visit, and spend a few moments with St. John Neumann.

Father Guckin – provided an update on Parish Security. Several enhanced measures are in place at OLMC to maintain the safety of parishioners

Spring DMI Survey– Results of the Disciple Maker Index (DMI) Survey were reviewed. Overall, respondents had a favorable view of the parish and pastor.

Staff/Team Updates

School: Dawn Parker – school is busy; enrollment is approximately the same as last year. Pre-K for next school year is already full and kindergarten is nearly so. Highlight of the week was the announcement of two Neumann Scholars.

Sara Jane McFadden – Trunk- or-Treat event went well with many ministries and cross-generational groups/families participating. Planning is now underway for the Santa Breakfast the first weekend in December.

PREP: Julianne Donahue – who has been with the program for over 20 years, is the new Director of OLMC's Parish Religious Education Program (PREP), same program as "CCD", only a different name. The borough has placed a 15mph speed limit in effect during session times on Sundays and Mondays. Other activities: a joint Christmas choir with both PREP and school students, 56 students participated in a retreat at Czestochowa on November 4. Total enrollment is 342 and PREP now has a beautiful logo designed by a parishioner!

Christine Weyer – new Director of Parish Discipleship. In addition to the pastoral component of her position, especially administering to those in senior centers, Christine has been very busy with several other activities. Among the activities: OCIA with Deacon William, weekly Walking with Purpose Women's Bible Study. The Chosen video series and 33 Days to Morning Glory, a consecration to Mary that recently began. Christine is also preparing for a 3rd pilgrimage to the sacred shrines in Philly, for parishioners in December.

Kathleen Boucher – presented a prototype of the OLMC anniversary Christmas ornament created made by Tileworks in Doylestown. Info re sales coming soon.

Mary Eileen Baltes – Director of Parish Engagement, spoke of the many opportunities for parish families to gather this year, especially the hospitality events, where five of the six events were hosted by partner ministries. OLMC has a new person, working off site, helping to refresh the parish website. Lucite holders near the church doors are in place, where those who may be unable to use the website, etc. can pick-up flyers about various parish events.

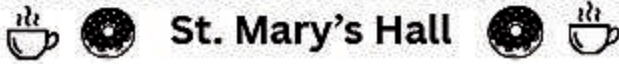

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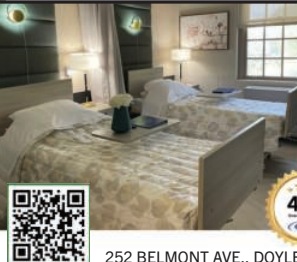


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
