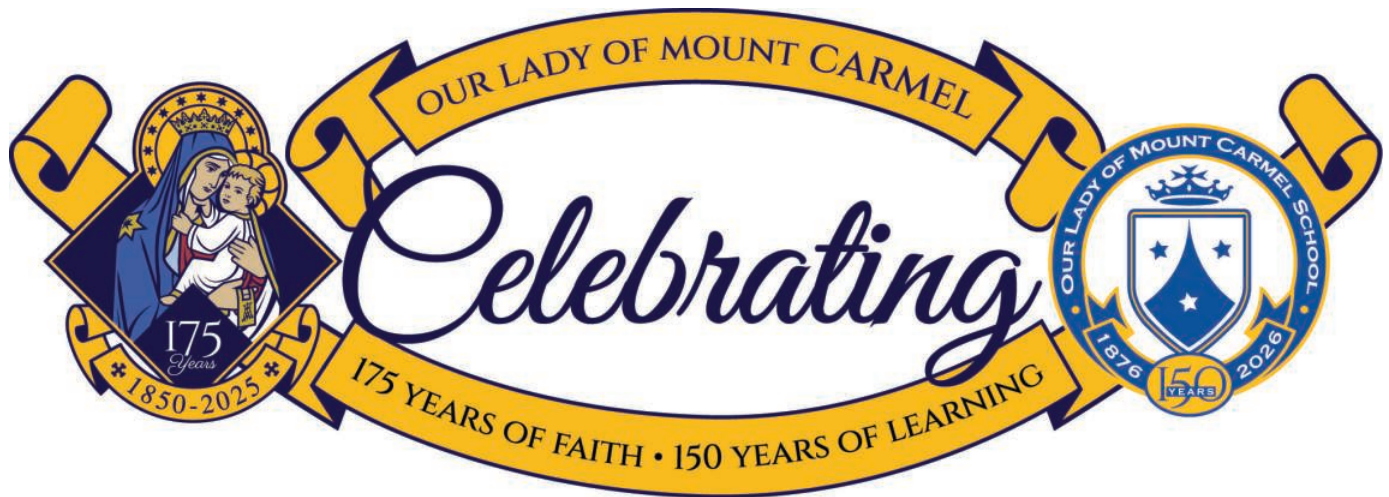




As we close the book on 2025 and open the book on 2026, I'd like to suggest five books that I believe will significantly strengthen your faith. Each of these books have had a tremendous influence on me and my relationships with God and others.

I intentionally left out any books from the Bible because, well, that kind of goes without saying. If asked, however, of the most important book ever, I'd have to answer *The Gospel According to Saint John*.

The first two I list below fit the category of "Pre-Evangelization." That is, they can create a foundation for the Gospel message to be better received.

Here are five books which I believe are indispensable for Catholic spirituality.

Make Your Bed by **Admiral William McRaven**. Admiral McRaven is a former Navy SEAL who provides simple wisdom and practical advice that helps us see the wisdom of bringing order out of chaos and building resiliency.

Man's Search For Meaning by **Viktor Frankl**. A psychiatrist, Frankl gives a riveting account of his time in Nazi death camps. Specifically, he notes how those who survived did so by intentionally connecting their experiences of suffering and torture with meaning and purpose.

The Screwtape Letters by **C.S. Lewis**. Simply brilliant. It consists of a series of brief



letters from a senior devil (Screwtape) to his nephew (Wormwood). The uncle writes the letters to mentor the nephew on how to tempt a Christian. Folks, this gives the reader profound insight on how temptation works.

The Life of Christ by **Archbishop Fulton Sheen**. Truly a classic! If the Bible could have another book in it this would be my suggestion. Fulton Sheen – with his typical eloquent simplicity – takes the reader through the birth, life, Crucifixion and Resurrection of Jesus.

Introduction to the Devout Life by **Saint Francis de Sales**. Francis wrote this to help Christians to appreciate and live out who Christ calls them to be. He explains what true devotion is and how devotion for laypersons is different than for religious and clergy – but no less intense!

St. Patrick Wall



The Patron Saint of Ireland, migrants and engineers is St. Patrick.

Born in Britain, St. Patrick brought Christianity to Ireland even though as a young boy he was forced into slavery in that country to tend sheep. After escaping back to Britain he began studying for the priesthood and soon felt a beckoning back to Ireland. Utterly confident in the Lord he began baptizing and confirming new followers far and wide.

One of the most famous legends of St. Patrick was his use of the shamrock to explain the doctrine of the Holy Trinity- one God in three persons. Catholicism still remains the dominant faith in Ireland today.

The Wall of St. Patrick in St. Mary's Cemetery Columbarium runs down the center and is one of three walls that faces in two directions. St. Patrick greets the sun rise every morning and the sunset every night.

Come pay a visit to St. Patrick and spend a little time.

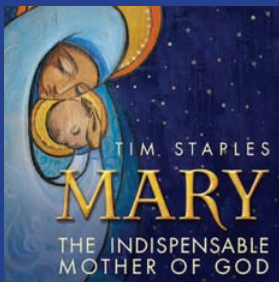

Pastoral Council Meeting - December 10, 2025

6:30 PM - Opening Prayer

Fr. Guckin reported that Mass attendance has increased substantially from October 2024 – October 2025 (+42%). He also stated that the new Catholic Family School Tuition Plan is supported by our bishops.

Focused Discussion

Pat Johnston of the OLMC St. Vincent de Paul (SVDP) Society shared the origin of the Society whose roots date back to the 1600's. Highlights of the presentation: SVDP Society is dedicated to helping the needy/poor with more than 800k members in 15 countries. The Society began at OLMC in 1989 and is known as, "The Our Lady of Mount Carmel Conference of the St. Vincent de Paul Society." OLMC has 30 Vincentians 16 of which take calls. Fifteen to 20+ calls are received weekly for some type of assistance. Members receive extensive, ongoing training and practice as Jesus taught. All funding comes from the church poor boxes, the annual SVDP collection and financial and food donations from parishioners.

Staff/Team Updates

PREP: Julianne Donahue – Food drive (October-November) brought in over 700 pounds of food. Deacon Chuck Dern met with parents of second grade students regarding First Communion which will take place in May. St. Nicholas visited and students are now practicing for the Christmas Pageant.

Sara Jane McFadden: OLMC ROCKs Santa Breakfast went well. About 300 children were expected though a Norovirus resulted in about 75% attendance. Approx. 75 gifts (which was a suggested donation for the families that attended) were received and donated to the Bucks County Housing Group.

Parish Discipleship: Christine Weyer – Winding down from a busy Fall. Two of four programs are ending. Working on keeping the website up-to-date about programs.

Deacon William – Will be offering a "mini retreat" for catechists in January.

Parish Engagement: Mary Eileen Baltes –End of year activities are coming to a close. Plans are underway for the New Year. Using "all of the channels" to make sure that everyone is aware of all that is going on and being offered in our parish community.

General Discussion

The Council had a general discussion on various topics including parish attendance at Mass and parish events, potential projects and future meeting topics.

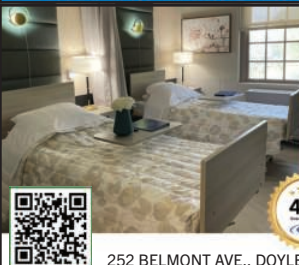
