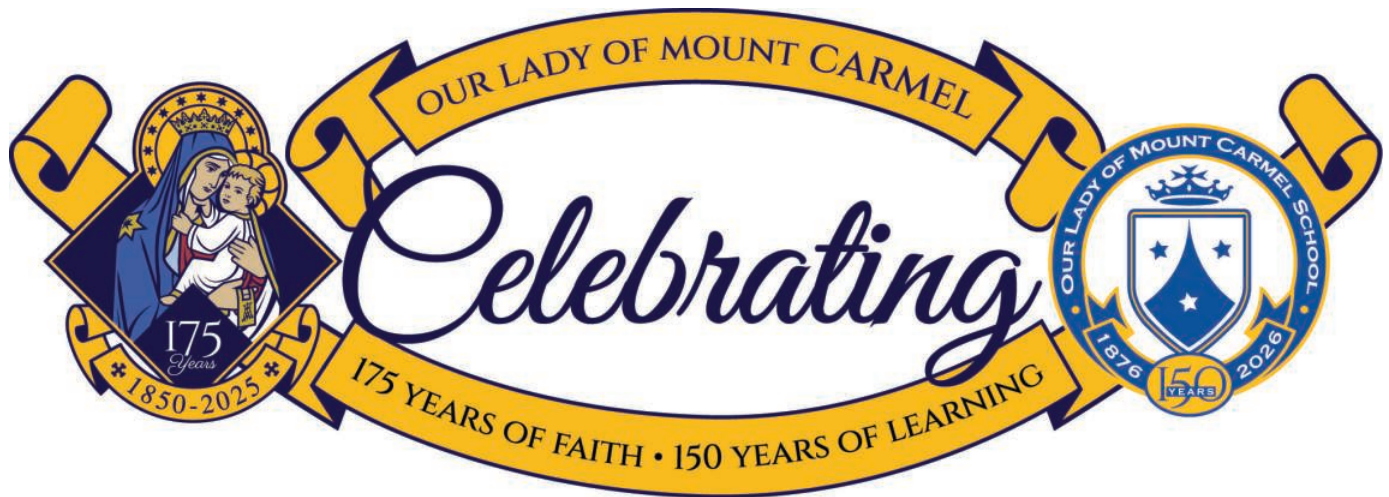




Dear Parish Family,

St. Teresa of Calcutta



While taking a stroll down the main center aisle of St. Mary's Columbarium you will find to your right, the Wall of St. Teresa of Calcutta. St. Teresa of Calcutta also known as Mother Teresa was born on August 26, 1910 in Skopje, Macedonia but spent the majority of her life in Kolkata (formerly Calcutta). She founded the Missionaries of Charity and dedicated her life to find and serve Jesus among the unwanted, the poor, and the unloved. She went to the slums and cared for the sick and dying. The Missionaries of Charity spread to over 133 countries and is still active today in service to the poor and sick, managing homes for the sick and dying, as well as the running of soup kitchens, mobile clinics and schools. St. Teresa of Calcutta's Feast day is the date of her death, September 5.

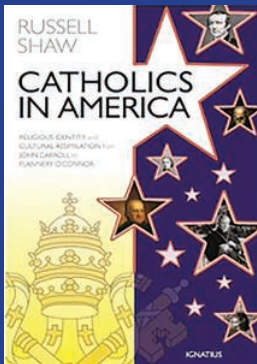

- You may be prompted to again text the donation amount, including the dollar sign, to the above number.
- After texting your donation amount, you will receive a text confirming that your donation has successfully processed.
- You are now set up to use text-to-give for future donations.

Donation Verification for Tax Purposes

If you would like a statement of your contributions/donations from the parish to use when preparing your tax return, please call the rectory office at **(215) 348-4190**.

Signed statements will be mailed to you within 3 weeks of your request. **Please request your statement no later than March 20, 2026.**

PLEASE NOTE: If you donate solely through Parish Giving, you will be emailed a statement from them, on our behalf for you to use for tax preparation. There would be no need to have a statement from OLMC. However, if you have made any contributions at Mass or through the mail, you should request a statement from us which would include both the Parish Giving contributions and the Mass and/or mail in contributions.

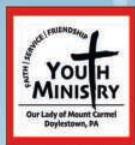

OLMC School

Dear Friends:

Our First LEGO League Robotics Team, the Bionic Bulldogs, is excited to be hard at work again this fall on this year's theme, Unearthed! Students are challenged to program and code a LEGO Spike Prime robot to complete missions on the Unearthed field, while also developing an innovation project that answers the question: "How can we help archaeologists safely learn more about underwater artifacts?"



We are grateful for the dedication and guidance of Mrs. Villalba and Mrs. McKendry, who introduced the project in September and led students through each step of the process. We also appreciate Mrs. Skelly, our computer teacher, who supported the team with 3D printing as students designed models for their innovation project. Through this collaboration, students created an underwater remotely operated vehicle (ROV) with a high-resolution camera and sonar, allowing archaeologists to explore underwater sites while preserving fragile artifacts.

Our robot pilots and coders—Andrew, Everett, Nick, Ronnie, Ben, Joe, and Jack—worked diligently on the robot game, while Angelina, Caroline, Coralie, Sam, Ben, and Peter led the innovation project. Ronnie and Ben, with support from Joe and Everett, produced detailed 3D-printed models to bring the project to life.

The Bionic Bulldogs competed for the first time in early December and impressed the judges with their teamwork and presentations. We are thankful to share that the team earned the Team Core Values Award and qualified for the regional competition at Malvern Prep on January 10th.

As they prepare for regionals, the students continue to innovate and seek expert feedback. We are especially grateful for the mentorship of high school students Joey and Matthew Frey and for the guidance of a systems engineer from Tinius Olsen, whose encouragement and insights have been invaluable. We thank God for the many talents, mentors, and opportunities that support our students, and we hope to once again earn a spot at the state competition for the third year in a row!

Caring for Friends

Caring for Friends (CFF) is one of the largest food banks and most comprehensive senior meals delivery programs in the five-county Greater Philadelphia region. It provides meals and visits to individuals who are homebound.

Currently CFF provides over 40,000 meals weekly with the support of pantry and shelter partners.

Our Lady of Mount Carmel has had a longstanding relationship with Caring for Friends. Dr. Maryann Galletta, an OLMC parishioner and coordinator of CFF at OLMC, is responsible for delivering frozen meals to the main hub in Philadelphia -- thanks to all the individual cooks who provide meals prepared with care in their own homes.

Help us fill our OLMC Caring for Friends freezer by preparing meals and freezing them. Cooking for CFF is a wonderful opportunity for discipleship that does not require meetings or time outside the home.



How to help:

1. Pick up a pack of Caring for Friends trays. These trays can be found in the room to the right of the Church Narthex (main vestibule) where the bathrooms are located. The trays are in a labeled wicker basket under the Information Center.
2. Return the filled trays (one at a time or as many as you have prepared) to the black soft-sided cooler under the bulletin board in the Church Narthex. The cooler is available during all weekend Masses.

Can you donate a car so someone struggling can work?

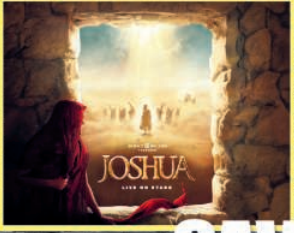

OLMC Prison Ministry

Each month the OLMC Prison Ministry's Religious Services Program offers Masses, Communion Services, Reconciliation, Bible Studies, and Christian Recovery Services for the men and women who are incarcerated in the three Bucks County correctional facilities. In the month of December 2025 we interacted with men and women via:

- Communion Services and Masses: 126 attendees
- Bible Studies: 33 attendees
- Confessions: NA

Through our Father Davids Mentoring and Reentry Program, volunteers from OLMC and other churches provided one-on-one mentoring within the jail and continuing after release.

- for approximately 20 people
- for a total of approximately 84 mentoring hours

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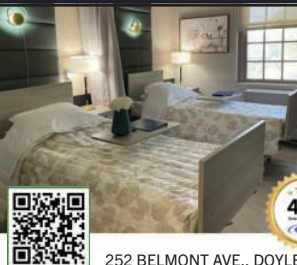


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
