

In our Gospel this weekend Jesus gives us the beatitudes – His program that teaches us how to become both morally excellent and perfectly happy.


Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. This means being **detached** from anyone or anything to which we have an unhealthy attachment.

Blessed are the meek, for they will inherit the land. Meekness is not weakness. In fact, it's the very opposite. Essentially, being meek means being able to control your tongue and emotions.

Blessed are they who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they will be satisfied. Speaking up for the unborn, standing up for the dignity of undocumented persons, having the nerve to criticize both sides of the political aisle when they're wrong. It puts an end to ideological tribalism.

Blessed are the merciful, for they will be shown mercy. When we are able to finally forgive and let go of grudges and resentments, the burdens these cause are lifted and it's like we ourselves have been forgiven.



Blessed are the clean of heart, for they will see God. A selfish heart that seeks personal glory, power, money, etc., is simply incapable of seeing God.

Blessed are they who are persecuted for the sake of righteousness, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. Just because we're being persecuted doesn't mean we're being righteous. Sometimes we're persecuted because we're stupid.

Blessed are you when they insult you and persecute you and utter every kind of evil against you falsely because of me. Rejoice and be glad, for your reward will be great in heaven. This, friends, is the consequence of being Catholic.

Also known as Saint Bernadette of Lourdes, Bernadette was the oldest of nine children. She was a young teen when Our Lady spoke to her at the grotto in Lourdes, France. Bernadette had 18 more encounters with "The Immaculate Conception," the name given to Bernadette when she asked. One day Bernadette was instructed by the "very beautiful lady"

to drink and wash from the muddy spring of the grotto, as a penance. She did so, and soon the spring began to run clear from the ground.

Bernadette joined the Sisters of Charity on July 29, 1866. There, she spent many hours in the infirmary as a nurse, and even though she suffered from ill health her whole life, Bernadette was always known for being kind and holy and having great wit.

St. Bernadette is the Patron Saint of poverty, illness and Lourdes, France.

The Wall of niches for St. Bernadette in our Columbarium is extra special because it is a Family Wall. There are six 12x12 niches that are reserved as a unit for the exclusive use of one family. This can be a very special resting place for a family of loved ones.

Be prepared to give your full name, correct mailing address, and phone number. It would be helpful to have your envelope number available.

Signed statements will be mailed to you within 3 weeks of your request. **Please request your statement no later than March 20, 2026.**

PLEASE NOTE: If you donate solely through Parish Giving, you will be emailed a statement from them, on our behalf for you to use for tax preparation. There would be no need to have a statement from OLMC. However, if you have made any contributions at Mass or through the mail, you should request a statement from us which would include both the Parish Giving contributions and your envelope and/or mail-in contributions.

Caring for Friends

Caring for Friends (CFF) is one of the largest food banks and most comprehensive senior meals delivery programs in the five-county Greater Philadelphia region. It provides meals and visits to individuals who are homebound.



Currently CFF provides over 40,000 meals weekly with the support of pantry and shelter partners.

Our Lady of Mount Carmel has had a longstanding relationship with Caring for Friends. Dr. Maryann Galletta, an OLMC parishioner and coordinator of CFF at OLMC, is responsible for delivering frozen meals to the main hub in Philadelphia -- thanks to all the individual cooks who provide meals prepared with care in their own homes.

Help us fill our OLMC Caring for Friends freezer by preparing meals and freezing them. Cooking for CFF is a wonderful opportunity for discipleship that does not require meetings or time outside the home.

How to help:

1. Pick up a pack of Caring for Friends trays. These trays can be found in the room to the right of the Church Narthex (main vestibule) where the bathrooms are located. The trays are in a labeled wicker basket under the Information Center.
2. Return the filled trays (one at a time or as many as you have prepared) to the black soft-sided cooler under the bulletin board in the Church Narthex. The cooler is available during all weekend Masses.




