

*The just man is a light in darkness to the upright!*

This is our response to our psalm (Psalm 112) at this weekend's Mass. We'll listen to it and sing it five times but it's something we need to hear often and say often throughout our lives.

It makes me think about George Bailey in *It's A Wonderful Life*. The character is a banker played by Jimmy Stewart who, throughout his life, sacrificed all his dreams in order to help his family and the little community of Bedford Falls.

His gave up so much that he came to believe that life had passed him by. This led him to resent his situation and made him fall into a deep despair. He then contemplated suicide. An angel named Clarence appeared to him and showed him how different life would be had he never existed: His wife would have been lonely, his children would never have been born, his uncle would have been insane, and Bedford Falls would have become sleazy.

George Bailey's good character and moral righteousness – as sacrificial as it was for him – made him a guiding light for his family and community without him even knowing it.

*The just man is a light in darkness to the upright!*

Sometimes I think it's easy to forget how dark the world is. So much sadness, such tragedy,



pathology everywhere. It's equally easy to forget that, by following Jesus, we become the light others need.

It's why Christ says to us in our Gospel this weekend: *You are the light of the world!* He didn't say *You are the light of the Church*. This little light of ours should be visible in school, at work, in the kitchen and on the golf course.

It's a light that needs to shine when we're driving around Doylestown or ordering a meal in a restaurant. Whether it's the language we use or the websites we visit, Christ commands us to be the light of the world.

And by so doing, we become a light in darkness to others.


