

I believe that one of the reasons so many Catholics have left the Faith is that our presentation of it has become superficial, unreal, and nicey-nicey.

Lent – which begins this Wednesday – is a privileged time when we are encouraged to honestly come to grips with our sins, our mortality, our moral frailty and our need for forgiveness.

To help us do this, I invite you to join with us here at Our Lady of Mount Carmel as we present the Catholic faith in a variety of ways.

We will celebrate Mass each weekday at 8 A.M. and Noon. Confession times will be extended by Father Flanagan and myself on Saturday afternoons and Wednesday evenings.

I will offer a Women’s Lenten Retreat on the morning of Saturday, February 28th, and a Men’s Retreat on the morning of Saturday, March 14th (each retreat lasting for three hours).

We will gather for the Stations of the Cross at 5:30 P.M. each Friday in Lent. This devotion – which lasts for 30 minutes – is unique to our parish as we consider each station from the perspective of Mary, the Mother of Jesus.

On Saturday, March 7th, we will offer a conference entitled *Dying Well: Having Your Affairs in Order*. We offered this two years ago and it was well received. Local funeral directors, attorneys, and an insurance expert will make brief presentations and answer your



questions in their fields of expertise. I will make a presentation on the Catholic ethics of end-of-life decision making and Father Flanagan will present on Catholic Funeral Masses.

On Monday, March 16th at 6:30 P.M., we will celebrate our Lenten Parish Penance Service.

On Thursday, March 26th, we are making our annual pilgrimage to the “Sight & Sound Theater” in Lancaster to watch a production of *Joshua*. Joshua foreshadows Jesus in the Old Testament and succeeded Moses for the Israelites. This is a GREAT way to learn about the Bible. Get your tickets now.

We will begin our discipline of Lent next week on Ash Wednesday at 8 A.M., Noon, and 7 P.M.



Saint Monica Wall



Saint Monica was the mother of one of the greatest saints in the history of the church: St. Augustine. Born in 331, she married early in life and had three children who survived infancy. As a devout Christian, she shed many tears when Augustine strayed from the church and went from one philosophy to another. Monica never gave up on her son and stayed close to him.

Her motherly affection and prayer led to Augustine's conversion and dedication to the service of Christ. While waiting to sail to Africa with Augustine to spread the Word of God, Monica fell ill and died. St. Monica rests today at the Basilica of Sant'Agostino, Rome.

St. Monica is celebrated for her patience, prayerful life and Christian virtues. She is the Patron Saint of mothers, widows, victims of abuse and alcoholics.

It is most appropriate that her Wall here in the Columbarium is a Family Wall since Monica was such a devoted wife and mother who set the example that even in the darkest of times, faith can light the way.
