

Temptation is rarely loud – it whispers.

It arrives dressed as comfort, success, pleasure, relief ... always asking for only a small compromise. And, in that moment, it feels harmless. Just one shortcut, one indulgence, one secret.

Yet, temptation's true power lies in its patience. It studies our loneliness, our pride, our hunger to be seen. And then it waits. The reality of temptation is not that it forces us but that it reveals us. It exposes the quiet battles between desire and discipline, impulse and integrity.

Every refusal to give in strengthens our character whereas every surrender reshapes it.

In our Gospel for this first Sunday of Lent there is a foreshadowing of the Passion. Jesus, all alone, fasts for forty days. He was hungry. His body had used up any fat reserves He had so that muscle tissue was breaking down causing tremendous pain.

Jesus made Himself vulnerable so as to expose the devil's methods of temptation.

The first temptation is always a temptation of the flesh. *Command that these stones become loaves of bread*, says the ugly beast. The flesh is always the easiest way to ensnare us! Outbursts of anger, foul language, lewd

behavior, gossip. The temptation is really this: Take charge and don't become fully dependent on God.

The second temptation is to pride. *If you are the Son of God throw yourself down*, commands this hideous brute. Create a spectacle, perform a public stunt, become a celebrity, draw attention to yourself! Lust, greed and anger are fleabites when compared to pride.



The final temptation is the seductive draw of life's finer things. *All these I will give you ... if you will worship me*, promises the repulsive fiend. Wealth, power, pleasure and honor are all good things provided they don't become something we want more than anything else.

Prayer trains us to depend entirely on God. **Fasting** helps us to master the "flesh" (rather than be mastered by it). And **almsgiving** (supporting the poor) reminds us to keep the finer things in life in perspective!

The last Family Wall in St. Mary's Columbarium honors St. Anthony of Padua. St. Anthony was a powerful Franciscan preacher and teacher as well as a true disciple of St. Francis of Assisi.

He is famously known as the Patron Saint of lost and stolen articles. This is because when his beloved book of psalms went missing he prayed for it to be found and returned. It was, and that book today is preserved in the Franciscan friary in Bologna.

Anthony displayed a steady courage to face the ups and downs of life, the call to love and forgive, and to always be concerned for the needs of others. He was a simple and humble friar. The last Lenten sermons he gave before his death drew crowds so large that churches could not hold them, and he had to go into the open fields to preach. St. Anthony was canonized less than a year after his death making him one of the quickest saints to be canonized in history. "Actions speak louder than words; let your words teach and your actions speak."


