

The first cry of a newborn child, a hymn sung so beautifully it feels like heaven, a bride walking down the aisle, catching a giant marlin, a young priest saying his first Mass, a sunrise on the beach at the Jersey Shore.

Life sometimes gives us moments that take our breath away. We naturally desire to hold on and stretch the seconds into eternity. But such moments are brief. They don't last forever.

This is precisely what happens in our Gospel this weekend. On a high mountain Jesus is transfigured before Peter, James, and John. His face gleamed like the sun and His clothes became dazzling white. His heavenly glory burst through His ordinary humanity.

Peter wanted to capture the radiance and make the moment last forever as he blurts out, "Lord, it is good for us to be here." He even wanted to build tents to make the moment last forever. He wanted to freeze time so that faith became effortless and joy would never again have a shadow of darkness to accompany it.

But the vision soon faded and the cloud lifted. These followers of Christ had to walk back down the mountain toward confusion and suffering.

Life occasionally gives us transfiguration moments. Like Peter, we whisper, "It is good for

us to be here." We take pictures and frame them and create videos to go back to and watch from time to time. Good memories ... however we capture them ... sustain us through our valleys of doubt, grief, and struggle.



Saint Peter did not have access to technology. But he did journal his experience. He faced tremendous mockery and persecution after the Crucifixion. His enemies would make rooster noises to remind him of his denials. His tears left furrows in his cheeks.

But roughly 30 years after the Resurrection Peter wrote about the Transfiguration (*see 2 Peter 1:16-18*). That great memory of Peter's gave him hope throughout the rest of his life. It's what gave him the courage to die for Jesus.

Savor your moments of transfiguration.





Down the first aisle
in the Columbarium
closest to St. Mary's
Cemetery you will find
the Columbarium Wall
of a very remarkable
woman, Saint Elizabeth
Ann Seton.

Born an Episcopalian in
New York City, Elizabeth
was married at 19 and
had five children with her husband, William. When
William became ill with tuberculosis they traveled to Italy
in hopes of improving his health. Unfortunately, William
died there and Elizabeth was left a young widow with
children. While in Italy friends exposed Elizabeth to the
Catholic faith and she was so deeply impressed by the
Catholic belief in the real presence that she converted
to Catholicism soon after her return to the United States.

After her conversion, Elizabeth established the first
sisterhood in the United States: The Sisters of Charity
of St. Joseph and their school was the first free Catholic
School in the country.

Canonized by Pope Paul VI, she was the first citizen
born in the United States to be given the title of "Saint."

During and after her lifetime, Elizabeth was known for
her devoutness to the Catholic Church as well as her
compassion and desire to help others.

Her Feast day is January 4, and she is the Patron Saint
of widows and Catholic Schools.

When spring arrives, please come have a seat and
pay a visit to the St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Wall in our
Columbarium and remember this Saint of the Church.

Parish School Presentation: Dawn Parker, School Principal and Michelle Stetler, OLMC School Director of Institutional Advancement, provided an overview and highlights of the school which is celebrating its 150th anniversary this year. Enrollment is 416, the school in its entirety is aligned with its mission statement. The school is accredited by Middle States.

Proclaiming the good news of Jesus is paramount as is worshipping as members of the community and providing service to the less fortunate. Education through strong academic programs, extracurricular programs and co-curriculars is key, in addition to empowering students to become leaders and serve in the world and in our Catholic community. The current academic goals are reading comprehension and OLMC's STREAM (Science, technology, religion, engineering, art and math). Credit for student retention is attributed to a strong faith-based education, smaller class sizes, academic. Parent involvement is encouraged and there is a "strong and dedicated" faculty, who are highly degreed. All teachers participate in catechetical certification classes which are a requirement. Additionally, enhanced security measures have been placed throughout the school.

Despite the snow, the recent Catholic Schools Week was a huge success, especially with the unexpected arrival of the Phillie Phanatic. The students enjoyed a pancake breakfast, a pizza lunch and school-wide bingo to win special prizes. On Friday morning, every class performed some type of service to benefit other organizations, followed by the celebration of a beautiful closing Mass.

Parishioners are encouraged to talk about our parish school and the EITC (education improvement tax credit) opportunity which is available and very important to the school.

The BLUE AND GOLD GALA, the only school fundraiser for this year will be held on April 10, 2026. All are encouraged to attend in support of the students and the school mission.

Mike Stefanski – Introduced a new project for an updated/ upgraded sound system in the Church. A discussion ensued and Council recommended that Father Guckin approve the project.

Parish Discipleship - Christine Weyer: Lenten events being offered include Friday evening Stations of the Cross, two retreats being presented by Father Guckin, Reconciliation opportunities, the production of "Joshua" at Sight & Sound Theater in Lancaster, and the "Dying Well" presentation being offered early March.


