

A couple of weeks ago I was teaching a class for those in our parish who are becoming Catholic at the Easter Vigil. One woman asked a great question – “When should I tell my family and friends that I am **converting** to Catholicism?”

I suggested that we avoid using the term “converting” because conversion, after all, is a life long journey. Instead, I proposed she say that she is embracing Catholicism to help her in her lifelong task of conversion.

In our Gospel this weekend, we witness not just a conversation at a well, but the slow, beautiful conversion of a heart.

When a Samaritan woman first meets Jesus at Jacob’s Well, she is defensive. “How can you, a Jew, ask me, a Samaritan woman, for a drink?” Her world had taught her to expect rejection.

But Jesus is patient. He does not overwhelm her. He gently leads her deeper.

At first, she sees Him only as a Jewish man. Then she calls Him “sir.” When He reveals knowledge of her complicated past, she recognizes Him as a prophet. Finally, when He speaks of the coming Messiah, and says, “I who speak to you am He,” her heart opens fully. The skeptic becomes a believer.

Her conversion is gradual. It moves from misunderstanding to curiosity to conviction to mission.



Notice what changes most: not her past, but her identity. She came to the well burdened, isolated, drawing water alone at noon. After encountering Christ, she leaves her water jar behind. That small detail says everything. The jar represents her old life. She no longer needs it.

Then she runs back to the very people she once avoided. The woman who once hid now proclaims: “Come see a man who told me everything I have ever done.” She is no longer defined by shame, but by grace.

Christ never forces Himself upon us. He invites. He reveals. He waits. And when we allow Him to truly see us—and love us anyway—our hearts are changed.

And once changed, we cannot keep Him to ourselves.

## Pray with the Saints of St. Mary's Cemetery Columbarium St. Thomas More



The St. Thomas More Wall in St. Mary's Cemetery is centrally located down the smaller walking aisle of the Columbarium. It faces west and receives the evening sun, but who was St. Thomas More?

Thomas More was born in London, England in 1478 and was the second of six children. In 1492 he attended Oxford to prepare for his future career as a lawyer. For a short time Thomas considered a life in the church by joining a Carthusian monastery in their daily spiritual exercises but decided to remain in the secular world. Even so, he never forgot the pious monks who inspired his practice of the faith.

Thomas married in 1505 and had four children. He was an affectionate father and a firm believer that his daughters receive the same education as his sons.

As secretary and personal advisor to Henry VIII, Thomas drafted official documents and welcomed foreign diplomats. He parted ways with Henry when he would not acknowledge the King as Supreme Head of the Church of England. After much turmoil, Thomas was arrested for treason and later executed.

Thomas More is also known for writing Utopia. Published in 1516 it describes the political system of an imaginary island state.

St. Thomas More is the Patron Saint of lawyers, statesmen and politicians.



At our Catholic school, we are continually inspired by the creativity and talent of our students, and this spring we are especially excited about two outstanding opportunities that nurture both imagination and innovation. Archbishop Wood High School has sponsored its cherished writing contest since the 1990s, and we were thrilled to once again participate. This beloved tradition invites students across grade levels to stretch their storytelling skills in unique and engaging ways using prompts supplied by Archbishop Wood. We were excited and proud to learn that Olivia Mehaffey won the prize for third grade and Scarlett Broadhead took the award for sixth grade!



We are equally proud to have our students participate in the 2026 K'Nex STEM Design Challenge, an exciting engineering competition for students in Grades 4–8. Working in teams of two to four, our young engineers were asked to design and build an original prototype using K'Nex materials, carefully documenting their ideas in a Design Notebook and drafting a detailed blueprint. This year's theme, "Eco-Factory: Build a Sustainable Production Machine," challenged students to design part of a factory that produces a product using sustainable practices. Their creations must demonstrate thoughtful stewardship of resources by minimizing waste, maximizing efficiency, and incorporating recycled or reusable materials where possible. Through this hands-on experience, students not only strengthen their STEM skills but also deepen their understanding of responsible care for our common home. Thirteen teams vied for the opportunity to win the school title with two of them moving on to the regional competition at the Bucks County IU. Congrats to fifth graders Isabella Barton, Juliana Prete and Maddy Scheetz and sixth graders Katie Benkert, Emily Cohan, Harper Mills and Cameron Schwarz. We wish you well!


