No sin is beyond God’s mercy ...

No sin is beyond God’s mercy ...

Judas Iscariot stands as a sobering portrait of remorse that turns inward and collapses into despair.


After betraying Jesus for thirty pieces of silver, Judas comes to recognize the gravity of his sin. Saint Matthew tells us that he is “seized with remorse” and returns the money to the chief priests, confessing, “I have sinned in betraying innocent blood.”

This moment is striking: Judas does not deny his wrongdoing, nor does he attempt to justify it. He sees clearly, perhaps for the first time, the truth of what he has done.

His remorse, though real, is tragically incomplete. Instead of leading him toward repentance and reconciliation, it isolates him. The religious leaders dismiss him, offering no guidance or mercy, and Judas, unable to bear the weight of his guilt, falls into despair and takes his own life.

His sorrow becomes self-consuming, closing him off from the possibility of forgiveness. In this way, Judas embodies a remorse that looks only inward, magnifying sin without opening to grace.

For Christians, Judas serves both as a warning and a contrast. Remorse is necessary—it is the awakening of conscience and the recognition of sin. But remorse



alone is not the end. When united with trust in God’s mercy, it becomes repentance, which leads to hope and restoration. The difference can be seen in figures like Peter, who also fails grievously but allows his sorrow to draw him back to Christ.

As we begin this Holy Week, let’s allow the key players in the drama which unfolds to reveal ourselves to ourselves.

And may the reality of Judas challenge us that our remorse must not end in despair. Instead, it should become a doorway to hope, reminding us that no sin is beyond God’s mercy when we are willing to return to Him.







## OLMC School

Dear Friends:



At Our Lady of Mount Carmel School, we are proud to provide a strong and faith-centered mathematics program that serves all learners. Following the curriculum of the Archdiocese of Philadelphia, our elementary mathematics program is carefully designed in alignment with Pennsylvania standards, the Core Standards of the Catholic Identity Curriculum Initiative, and the recommendations of the National Council for Teachers of Mathematics. Within this framework, our teachers emphasize the core mathematical practices of problem-solving, reasoning, precision, constructing viable arguments, critiquing the reasoning of others, modeling, using appropriate tools strategically, and recognizing structure. These practices help our students grow not only in perseverance as learners.



perseverance as learners.

To meet the diverse needs of our students, we offer both traditional and honors math pathways. In both tracks, teachers provide engaging opportunities for students to deepen their understanding through hands-on learning and creative projects. Our honors math students, for example, have explored fractions by designing "pizza box" projects in fourth grade, carefully dividing pizzas into equal parts, adding toppings, and identifying fractions and equivalent fractions. In middle school, seventh grade honors students applied their knowledge of graphing and slope by designing beautiful stained glass windows, identifying positive, negative, zero, and undefined slopes. Sixth grade honors students recently worked collaboratively to solve equations that guided them in drawing imaginative "math monsters," blending problem solving with creativity.

Students in our traditional math program are equally engaged and inspired. Eighth graders created their own stained glass designs which incorporated the various slope formulas such as standard form and slope-intercept form, graphing linear equations with purpose and creativity. Seventh graders explored ratios and proportions through a scale model project, enlarging a candy bar to understand real-world applications of math concepts. Across all grade levels, our students have embraced these opportunities to be both analytical and artistic, discovering that mathematics is not only about numbers, but also about creativity and exploration. We are grateful for your continued support as we guide our students to use their God-given talents to think critically, work collaboratively, and grow in knowledge and faith.


