

I'm just so very grateful to Archbishop Perez for assigning me to Our Lady of Mount Carmel. I'm part of a great community here, one rooted in the Resurrection of Jesus Christ!

I share these thoughts today to – hopefully – give a little insight into my heart as to what Easter means to me.

Easter is important to me because it speaks directly to the deepest hopes and struggles of my life. At its heart, Easter proclaims that suffering and death do not have the final word. The resurrection of Jesus reminds me that even in moments of darkness, loss, or uncertainty, there is always the promise of new life. This gives me a sense of hope that is not based on circumstances, but on a deeper level that God is at work, bringing light out of darkness.

Easter also challenges me personally. It calls me to move beyond fear, doubt, and complacency, and to live with greater faith and courage. Just as the disciples were transformed by the resurrection, I am reminded that I, too, am invited to change—to leave behind whatever holds me back and to live more fully in love, mercy, and forgiveness. Easter is not just something that happened long ago; it is something meant to happen within me right now.



Another reason Easter matters to me is because it strengthens my sense of community. Celebrating Easter, especially here at Mount Carmel, connects me with others who share the same faith and hope. Together, we remember that we are not alone in our struggles or in our joy. The shared celebration of the resurrection creates a sense of unity and belonging that is deeply meaningful.

Ultimately, Easter is important to me because it gives my life direction and purpose. It reminds me that love is stronger than sin, that hope is stronger than despair, and that life is stronger than death. These truths shape how I see the world and how I try to live each day.
