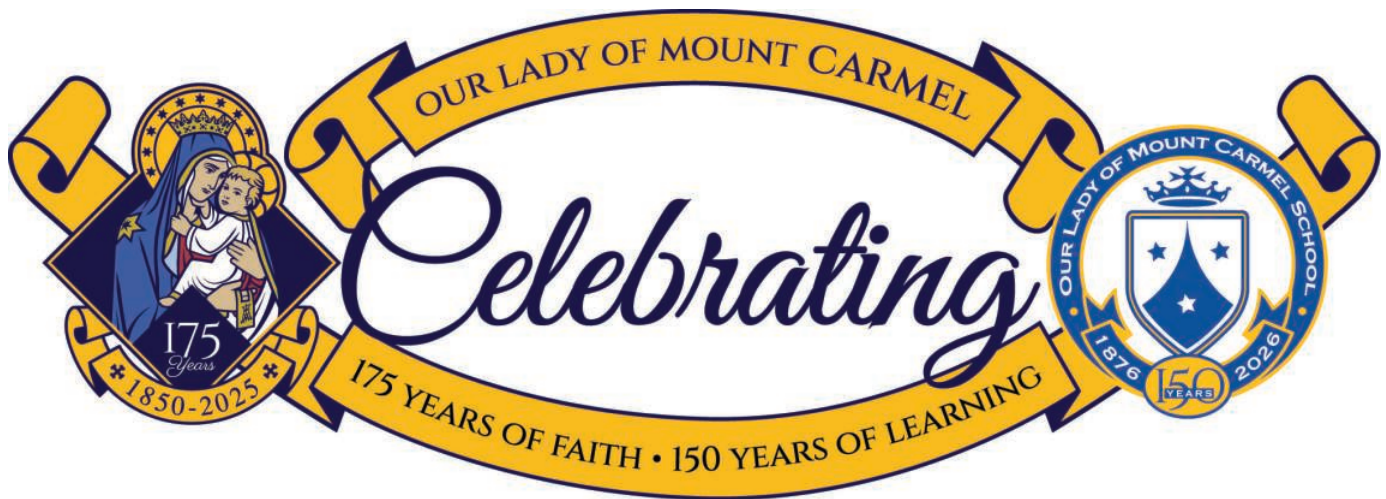




On The Topic of Prayer: Week One

The Spirit comes to the aid of our weakness, for we do not know how to pray as we ought ...

Though Saint Paul wrote these words to Christians in Rome in the first century, they're just as relevant to us in Doylestown today. Because when it comes to prayer, there are so many questions to consider:

- 1) What precisely is prayer?
- 2) If God already knows everything (*omniscience*), why pray at all?
- 3) If God is all-powerful (*omnipotence*), why doesn't He just act without us?
- 4) If God never changes, how can prayer matter?
- 5) Why are some prayers not answered?
- 6) What are the different "forms" of prayer?
- 7) How can we grow in prayer?
- 8) What gets in the way of prayer?

Having just finished nine days of praying within our Novena (and given Saint Paul's words to us this weekend), I'd like to spend a few weeks addressing questions such as these so that, together, we can grow in our love for the Lord Jesus.

So what is meant by prayer?

For our purposes, I'm using a definition by a seventh century monk from Syria: Saint John of Damascus. He wrote that prayer is "the raising of the mind and the heart to God." Put another way, praying involves much more than saying words. It's a deliberate turning of our entire self toward God.

The mind refers to our thoughts and understanding of reality. In prayer we think about God rather than ourselves. We reflect on His goodness, His words and His works. On the other hand, the heart refers to our deepest desires, fears and emotions. Raising our hearts to Him means entrusting Him with our worries, thanking Him for our blessings and longing to be with Him for all eternity.

In a few weeks (August 8th & 9th) we'll listen to a powerful prayer that Saint Peter speaks. When Peter was about to drown in the Sea of Galilee he cried out, "Lord, save me!" Those three, one-syllable words made up a very profound prayer. Peter's mind understood that Jesus could save him and in his heart he trusted Jesus completely.

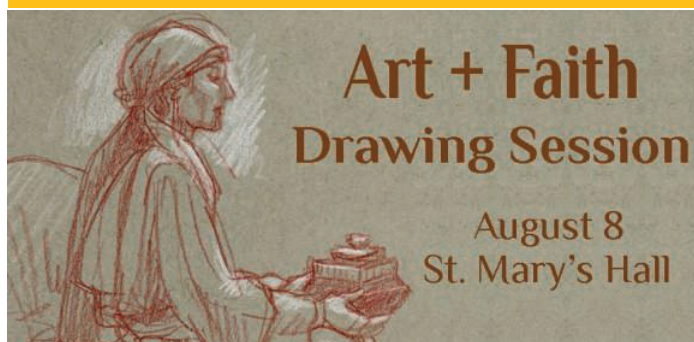
