



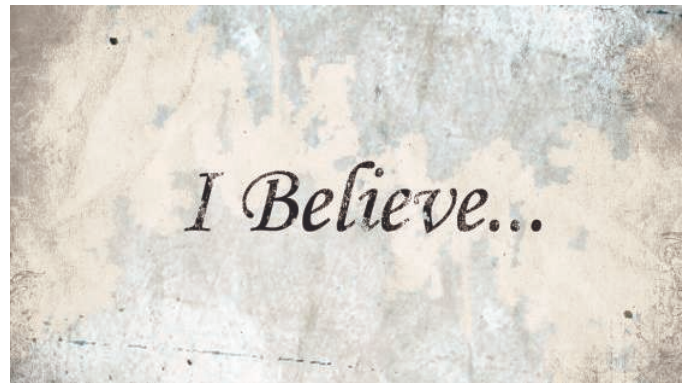
In my first year in the Seminary, a priest-professor was teaching us about ‘the sixties.’ He spoke of it as a time of revolution, experimentation and liberation. But my classmates and I soon realized he wasn’t referring to Woodstock, the Moon Landing, or Vietnam. In fact, he wasn’t talking about the 1960s at all. Instead, he was trying to teach us about the 60’s, that time when Christianity was first being spread by the early Church!

Since then I’ve learned that, in the Church, we don’t speak in terms of years or even decades. We tend to speak in terms of *centuries*.

2025 marks the 1700th Anniversary of the creed we recite each week at Mass: The Nicene Creed.

In 325 A.D., bishops gathered in Nicaea, an ancient Greek city. Their purpose in gathering was to address a controversy that was challenging the divinity of Jesus Christ. Specifically, the controversy was created by a priest named Arius. According to Arius, Jesus Christ was *not* divine and was simply a great man among men.

Saint Nicholas (yes, *that* Saint Nicholas) was one of the bishops who was present at the Council of Nicaea. While Arius was



defending his heresy at the platform, Jolly Ole’ Saint Nick walked across the room and punched him right in the chops. Why? Because Arius’ belief system reduces Jesus to an ethical guide, a mere teacher, and leads us away from His ultimate mission as our Savior.

The Nicene Creed was created at the Council of Nicaea to affirm our core beliefs about the nature of God as a Trinity of Persons. It addresses both the divinity and humanity of Christ, the hallmarks of His Church, and the eternal life to come.

Over the next few weeks, I’ll do my best to explain this Creed we pray each week with the hope that it becomes more meaningful to us each time we proclaim it.

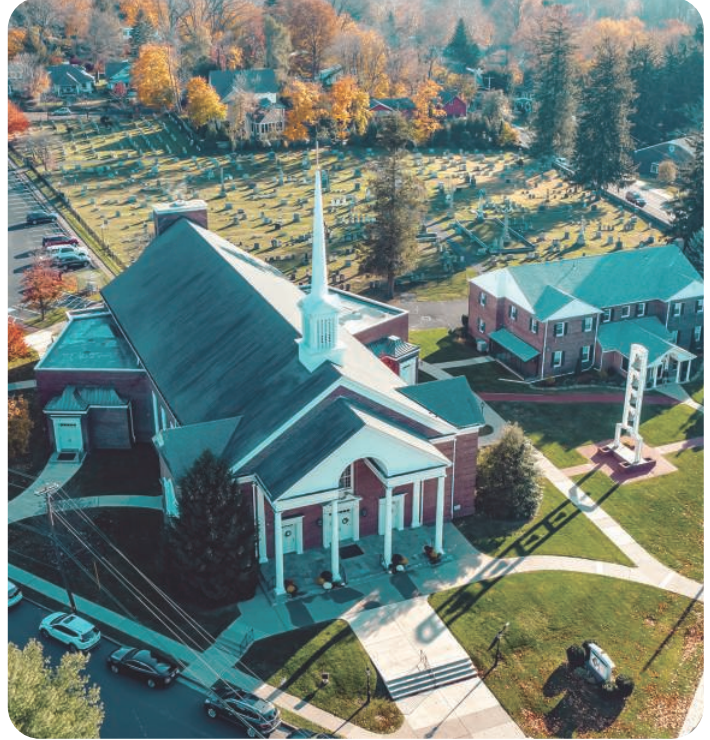

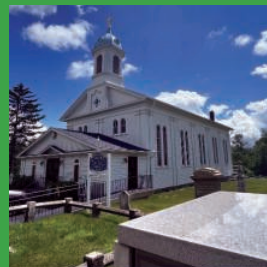

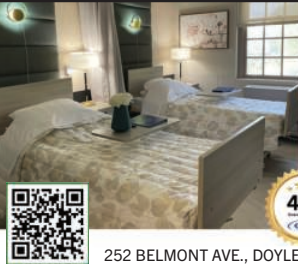
