## **Success in Uncertain Times**

On March 11, 2020, the Bicentennial Campaign officially surpassed its target of raising \$60 million throughout the Diocese of Charleston. In the following days, the world changed. With the rise of COVID-19 came widespread Mass restrictions, a suspension of all in-person parish activity, and sudden uncertainty regarding the overall success of the Bicentennial Campaign. The importance of keeping our parishes afloat through the difficulty of the pandemic dwarfed our Diocesan-wide capital campaign, yet the donations kept coming.

Since March of last year, the Bicentennial Campaign has almost raised an additional \$10 million from over 2,500 families. Even though many parishioners are still participating in Mass from their homes and normal parish activity is still returning to its normal levels, it is clear that South Carolina Catholics have kept the faith in their Church. We owe this success to the unrelenting commitment from our pastors, parish staff, and volunteers.

As we enter the fulfillment phase of the campaign, please know that the CCFSC and the Diocese of Charleston remain dedicated to providing the same level of communication and support to which you are accustomed. We are excited to keep sharing the good news with you.

## **Achievement Across the Deaneries**

## AIKEN DEANERY

Our Lady of Lourdes in Greenwood, SC ran a combined effort with the Bicentennial Campaign to build a new Family Life Center known as St. Bernadette's Hall. After a very successful campaign in 2018, construction for this expansion project was completed in the Fall of 2020. The parish is now enjoying the new office space, kitchen, and gathering areas offered by St. Bernadette's Hall.

## **BEAUFORT DEANERY**

St. Peter in Beaufort, SC carriedout one of the most successful campaigns throughout the Diocese. The parish aimed to usher in a renewed future in strong financial standing through the Bicentennial Campaign, and has since paid off all parish debt and purchased a new property to establish a strong community outreach center.

## **CHARLESTON DEANERY**

St. John in North Charleston, SC focused on improving the safety of their church by renovating the stairway to its choir loft, which was previously unstable. The Bicentennial Campaign has since enabled the parish to conduct this much-needed project, the first of its numerous case elements to upgrade its parish and school facilities.

## **COLUMBIA DEANERY**

Transfiguration in Blythewood, SC sought to expand their campus by constructing a classroom addition, a new kitchen, and storage space to more adequately accommodate their vibrant parish activity. Since last year, the funds that Transfiguration has received through the Bicentennial Campaign have allowed for the completion of this beautiful new space.

## **Living the Gospel Through Social Outreach**



### St. Clare's Home - \$126.470

St. Clare's Home of Joyful Hope is a maternity home for women who find themselves in a crisis pregnancy with no place to go and seemingly no other options. The home, nestled on 16 acres in Greenville County, provides a real alternative to abortion for pregnant moms by reaching out in love to them and their unborn babies.

The Catholic Church is taking strides in breaking the cycles of single parenthood and poverty by providing mothers experiencing crises with a "home" and a loving environment. The Diocese is committed to setting up our mothers and their children for healthy lives and preserving the sanctity of life starting at conception. To do so, Bicentennial Campaign funds slated for St. Clare's Home of Joyful Hope total \$1,000,000.

Through your generosity, women who stay at St. Clare's Home will live in community with other mothers to share their journey, and receive health and maternal care from the Sisters of St. Michael of the Archangel, who will staff the home.



## Hispanic Ministries — \$15.000

As the Hispanic population in our diocese continues to grow, we must maintain our welcoming efforts towards the Spanish-speaking community and facilitate their integration into the family of faith. It is imperative that we commit the needed resources to ensuring our Hispanic brothers and sisters grasp a full understanding of the Catholic faith and its holiness as they become familiar with life in South Carolina.

The CCFSC is proud to provide the funds necessary to hire a Hispanic Family Coordinator with the Office of Hispanic Ministry and Family Life. This important role will aid Hispanic couples to fully understand the sanctity of married life through Catholic programs, retreats, and local gatherings. Additionally, the Foundation will support our Hispanic priests, deacons, and religious sisters with training to improve their leadership and pastoral service in counseling those dealing with grief, depression, and other psychological issues.

To jumpstart these important initiatives for our Hispanic Ministry, a total of \$15,000 has been granted by the CCFSC.

## Campus Ministry - \$58,000

The Fellowship of Catholic University Students (FOCUS) is a Catholic collegiate outreach whose mission is to share the hope and joy of the gospel with college and university students, inspiring and equipping them for a lifetime of Christ-centered evangelization, discipleship, and friendships in which they lead others to do the same.

FOCUS missionaries at the University of South Carolina in Columbia and Coastal Carolina University in Conway are determined to ensure Catholic students feel connected to the Word of God as their studies prepare them for their next steps in life. It is important that our young academics involved with FOCUS are able to conduct Bible studies, outreach events, mission trips, and one-on-one discipleship so that they may avoid distraction from the joyful message of Jesus Christ's love.

As the University of South Carolina and Coastal Carolina are two prominent college

preferences for young Catholics from across the country, it is imperative that the respective FOCUS missions at these campuses have the resources necessary to maintain a strong presence to continue making disciples. The Catholic Community Foundation of South Carolina is proud to grant a total of \$58,000 to these Campus Ministries in Columbia and Conway for the purpose of serving the young faithful.

### **GREENVILLE DEANERY**

St. Paul the Apostle in Spartanburg, SC ran one of the most successful efforts of the Bicentennial Campaign. Recognizing a larger share of the funds would come back to the parish if it surpassed 125% of its target, St. Paul the Apostle reached 220% of their \$820,000 goal, providing the parish the funds to pay down its mortgage debt and address maintenance needs.

## **MYRTLE BEACH DEANERY**

St. Mary Our Lady of Ransom in Georgetown, SC saw its parish family come together for the purpose of ensuring their church's foundation and all of its amenities are sustainable, secure, and efficient. By raising over 200% of its Bicentennial Campaign target, the parish is able to begin mapping a long-range plan to make certain their historic church and its campus will last for generations.

## **ROCK HILL DEANERY**

St. Anne in Rock Hill, SC has experienced significant growth in recent years, requiring an expanded parking lot to sufficiently accommodate their church and school. With the funds raised through the Bicentennial Campaign, not only will St. Anne be able to increase the number of available parking spaces on its campus, an emergency access road will also be installed.
