
From the wild, windswept vineyards of Tasmania comes a rosé that feels like sunshine in a glass. Jansz Tasmania is no ordinary sparkling house — it's the island's original méthode traditionnelle specialist, founded in 1986 and devoted solely to sparkling wines. This Premium Rosé is their most playful expression, crafted from fruit sourced across Tasmania's top cool-climate sites: from the breezy banks of the Tamar Valley in the north to the serene slopes of the Coal River Valley in the south.

At the heart of it all lies the Pipers River region, home to the Jansz vineyard, a place known not just for pristine Pinot Noir, but also for its coastal wildlife. In fact, little penguins, the world's smallest penguin species, are known to nest near these vineyard coastlines. It's a uniquely Tasmanian harmony of nature and viticulture.

The blend is 94% Pinot Noir with a dash of Chardonnay and a whisper of Meunier. Think strawberries and cream, rose petals, Turkish delight, and warm brioche on the nose. The palate is creamy and textured yet dances with bright acidity like a summer picnic wrapped in elegance. And because this is a non-vintage cuvée, released just three months after disgorgement, it's designed to be enjoyed fresh, vibrant, and joyfully now with no aging required.

Maison Henriot is a name I return to again and again, not just for the wine, but for the philosophy behind it. Founded in 1808 by Apolline Henriot, a visionary widow who believed deeply in the expressive power of Champagne terroir. At a time when female leadership in wine was rare, she built a house that still bears her name — placing her among Champagne’s legendary widows like Veuve Clicquot and Madame Pommery. The Brut Souverain is their historic cuvée, and it’s a poetic blend of 29 crus — a true mosaic of Champagne.

With a generous 45% Pinot Noir, 40% Chardonnay, and 15% Meunier, this wine is a masterclass in balance. Aged for at least three years and crafted with up to 50% reserve wines, it’s layered and expressive. Imagine the aroma of warm citrus cake lifted by hints of chalk and smoke, followed by a palate of stone fruits and red berries — all underpinned by a persistent freshness that makes the wine feel alive. The structure is round and ample, yet refined, never overstepping its elegance.
