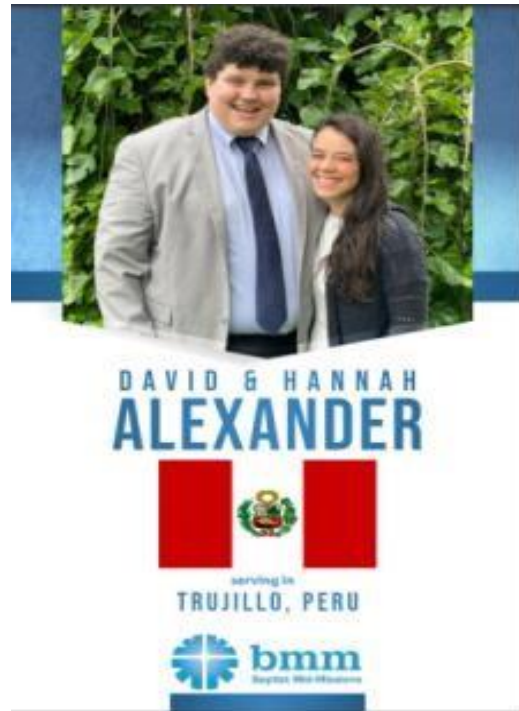


Alexanders to Peru

Hello, prayer partners!

We send our greetings from New Hampshire, just 30 minutes south of Canada. In some ways, it is hard to believe that January has flown past already. But God continues to show Himself faithful!

The first full week of January was spent figuring out our vehicle situation (more about that later). We had a car in time to make it to our first meeting of the year in Illinois on the second Sunday.
