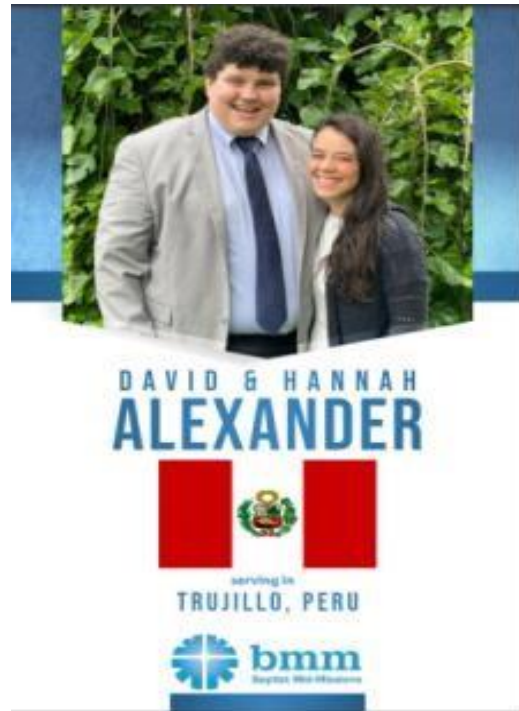


Alexanders to Peru
