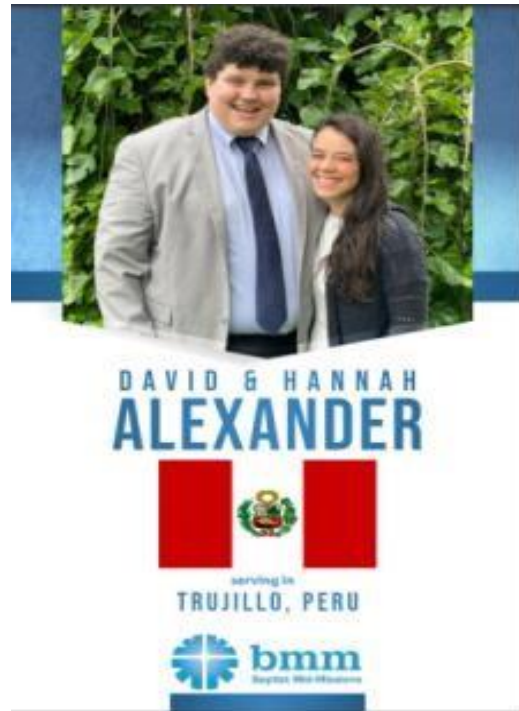


Alexanders to Peru

We are praising God for more advancement with the team in Peru. 2 more families have completed deputation and are either on the field or headed off to language school. God is doing great things, and we're just glad to have a piece of it.
