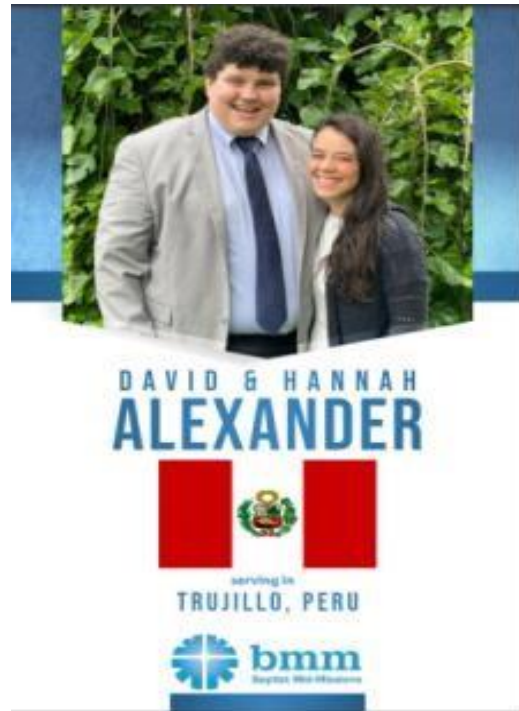


# Alexanders to Peru
