

### 2025 AC BREA THANKSGIVING CUP

#### TOURNAMENT RULES

#### **GENERAL**

This Class I & III tournament is open to all Club, Signature, and AYSO+ teams (Boys & Girls U8–U19) from US Club Soccer, USSSA, Cal South, AYSO, and all USSF-affiliated teams. Qualifying applications will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to accept or reject any application.

All decisions of the referees and tournament officials are final. No protests will be tolerated.

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

- Teams will play in the 2025–2026 age groups and must use approved 2025–2026 player ID cards and medical release forms.
- U8–U10 will play 7v7; U11–U12 will play 9v9 (no exceptions).
- Teams must be affiliated with FIFA/USSF through US Club Soccer, Cal South, USSSA, or AYSO.
- Unlimited loan players permitted.
  - Max roster sizes:
    - U8–U10: 14 players
    - U11-U12: 16 players
    - U13–U19: 18 players
- AYSO player cards are accepted. Guest players from AYSO/non-USSF organizations must have an approved US Club/Cal South/USSSA card.
- Digital or Physical Laminated cards are acceptable.

### **ROSTERS & TEAM REGISTRATION**

- Teams must register at least 60 minutes before their first game at their playing venue.
- No roster additions after the first game.
- Player cards or medical releases may be submitted later only if the player is already listed on the official roster at registration.
- Teams must submit the official roster (from the "Roster Form" link on the tournament page) signed by the Coach or Manager.

- All teams must present laminated or digital player cards with photos and corresponding medical releases.
- Each team must have a licensed coach or assistant with a valid coaching ID.
- No player may participate on more than one team in the tournament.

# **CHECK-IN BEFORE EACH GAME**

- Teams must check in 1 hour before each match.
- Field Marshal will hold player Roster cards.
- Referees have final authority on equipment safety.
- Coaches/administrators must retain medical releases during games.

#### **GAME PROCEDURES**

- ID cards and rosters will be verified at check-in.
- All teams must have a licensed coach and carded admin at every match.
- Minimum players:
  - o U8–U10: 6 players
  - o U11–U19: 7 players
- Teams sit on opposite sides of the field.
- Home team sits North or West.
- In case of color conflict, Away team changes jerseys.
- Home team supplies 3 game balls unless tournament provides them.
- No coin toss: Home chooses direction; Away kicks off.
- Games will start on time. No injury time added.

#### **UNIFORMS**

- Home Team = Light Colors
- Away Team = Dark Colors
- Away Team will change only jersey tops if there is a color conflict.

# **BUILD-OUT LINE (U10 and Below)**

- Opposing team must retreat behind the build-out line when the goalkeeper has the ball.
- Keeper may pass, roll, or throw the ball (no punts or drop kicks).
- Play resumes once ball is in play and opponents may cross the build-out line.
- Offside judged from the build-out line.

- Infraction:
  - Tournament rule: 1 warning per team, subsequent = Indirect Free Kick outside penalty area.

# **DELIBERATE HEADING (U11 AND BELOW)**

- Not permitted.
  - o Restart: Indirect Free Kick from spot (moved outside penalty area if needed).
- Dropped ball for accidental head contact during injury stoppage.

### **MATCH RULES**

All games follow FIFA Laws as modified by US Club, USYS, CYSA-S, and AC Brea.

# Additional Match Rules

- Semi-Final & Final ties go straight to Kicks from the Mark (no OT).
- 5-team pools have no finals; all games are pool play and may end in a tie.

- Preliminary games may end in a tie.
- Games will be stopped 5 minutes before next scheduled match.
- Teams not ready at scheduled time will forfeit.

# PLAYER EQUIPMENT

- Shin guards required.
- Legal soccer cleats only (no toe cleat).
- No dangerous equipment or jewelry.
- No player may play with an unsafe injury.

### **SUBSTITUTIONS**

- Unlimited, with referee permission.
- Allowed for both teams on any stoppage.
- Injured players requiring attention must be substituted.
- Substitutes must wait at midfield and enter only when waved on.

# **SCORING SYSTEM (10-Point System)**

- Win = 6 points
- Tie = 3 points
- Loss = 0 points
- Shutout win = +1
- Goals scored = +1 each (max 3 per game)
- 0-0 tie = 3 points each
- Red Card (player/coach) = -3 points
- Coach ejection without red = -3 points
- Forfeit score = 1-0

Teams forfeiting a pool game may have all pool games scored 0–1 (Tournament Director discretion).

#### **TIEBREAKERS**

- 1. Head-to-Head
- 2. Goal Differential
- 3. Goals For

- 4. Goals Against
- 5. Most Shutouts
- 6. FIFA Kicks from the Mark

Three-way ties go directly to Kicks from PK Mark.

#### **AWARDS**

- Champions: Medals + Team Trophy
- Finalists: Medals
- All participants receive an AC Brea Thanksgiving Pins.

#### **CONDUCT**

- Coaches are responsible for players, spectators, and bench conduct.
- Sideline coaching allowed if positive and instructional.
- No derogatory remarks, profanity, or disruptive behavior.
- Referee abuse or misconduct may result in suspension or tournament expulsion.
- Red Cards:
  - o Minimum 1-game suspension.
  - o Double yellow = ejection + 1-game suspension + -3 points.
- Teams must provide the ID of any ejected player/coach or will forfeit remaining games.
- Referee assault = immediate expulsion.

Cards will be reported to governing organizations.

### **INCLEMENT WEATHER**

If unsafe conditions occur:

- Games at halftime or later = final.
- Games in first half may be shortened or decided by kicks.
- If tournament is cancelled before starting, games will move to scheduled make-up weekend.

#### REFUND POLICY

• Full refund for all teams not accepted.

- Teams withdrawing before the registration deadline receive a full refund.
- After Nov 10, 2025, no refunds.
- If tournament cancelled within one week due to weather/Act of God, event will be played on make-up date.

# **SCORE CORRECTIONS**

Coaches must review posted scores and report errors immediately.

Corrections allowed if:

- Both teams and Field Marshal agree.
- Referee verifies incorrect score.
- Field Marshal verifies discrepancy from match record.

# **VENUE RULES**

- No smoking.
- No pets.
- No alcohol or intoxication.
- Illegal activity handled by Brea Police.

All games are final. No protests allowed.
