

Thank you for choosing Audubon Women's Medical Associates, PC for your pregnancy care.

A little about our office:

During your pregnancy you will be cared for by 5 physicians and 6 nurse practitioners. We ask that you meet at least 3 of our physicians and 1 of our nurse practitioners during your pregnancy. You can expect to have appointments approximately every 4-6 weeks until 30 weeks gestation and then appointments increase to every 2 weeks. The last month of pregnancy we will see you weekly. Please call us anytime you have a concern or medical question, we will always accommodate an emergency appointment if you have a concern.

PRIOR TO YOUR 1ST APPOINTMENT PLEASE CHECK WITH YOUR INSURANCE COMPANY TO CONFIRM COVERAGE OF LAB SERVICES.

Additional Services:

Ultrasound Services: We have two on-site ultrasound machines in our office and 4 highly trained Sonographers. Ultrasounds are offered every day, Monday through Friday. There is only one medically indicated ultrasound in pregnancy, it is performed between 18-20 weeks gestation. Your health care provider will decide if any other ultrasounds in your pregnancy are necessary.

Mental Health Services: Audubon has 2 independent private therapists located on site within our office. Based upon availability, patients may schedule an appointment to see Lori Badach (private therapy) or Alicia Kohlhagen (private therapy) at Audubon Women's. If scheduling limitations arise, a listing of recommended community providers will be given. The onsite therapists participate with most major insurances.

When it's time for the baby to arrive:

We deliver babies after 32 weeks at Millard Fillmore Suburban Hospital. If your baby should decide to arrive a little early, all deliveries prior to 32 weeks' gestation are delivered by the physicians at Sisters Hospital and/or Galisano Children's Hospital. We also cross cover with a group of board-certified OB/GYN physicians at Suburban Women's Healthcare. Suburban Women's may be on call for our group for any emergency hospital care or deliveries for our patients.
