These are your go-to responses for when someone requests a favor that is a huge inconvenience, but you would rather die than disappoint. It's not exactly disingenuous — it's just a little neurotic. Again, welcome to the club.

You know who doesn't belong to this club? The Blessed Mother. For many reasons, I'm sure, but the biggest one is that she's always completely up-front. Take her response to the Angel Gabriel: "Let it be done."

If there are more powerful words than these, I can't think of them now. And yet, as responses go, this certainly isn't an enthusiastic one. There was never a human creature more willing to obey God than Mary, full of grace, so it makes it all of the more striking that her response to Gabriel is this reserved — and it makes it all the more certain that she means exactly what she says.


"Behold, I am the handmaid of the Lord."

#### How do you pray when you don't have the words?

So often we think prayer is about words, about telling God our needs, asking him for help, reviewing a list of prayer requests. Yet, prayer is also about silence.

Sometimes the words just won't come. The pain is too deep, the grief overpowering, the hurt indescribable. Times your mind just can't process what you're going through and you are unable to find words.

Do you tend to skip prayer on these days when the words won't

These are the times you need to pray anyway. Especially in these times you need to pray. Even when your mind can't form the words

Prayer is so much more than the words you pray. Prayer is also sitting in the silence with God.

Prayer is allowing the Holy Spirit to intercede for you with wordless groans, praying for you when you cannot.

In the same way, the Spirit helps us in our weakness. We do not know what we ought to pray for, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us through wordless groans. Romans 8:26 NIV)

Prayer is also just spending time in God's presence, sitting in the silence with him. Listening instead of talking. Allowing him to refresh your heart through the silence.

When all you can manage are wordless groans, know that the Holy Spirit will intercede on your behalf. He knows your needs, even when you can't yet articulate them yourself.

Allow yourself to sit in that silence with God and simply ask the Holy Spirit to pray for you, to know your needs and know your heart.

So, when you don't have the words for prayer, pray anyway! Sit in the silence with God and allow the silence to be your prayer.


